The resolution in favour of the Potomac Company, the resolution in favour of Sarah Tillard, and the resolution in favour of William Wood, severally endorsed "assented to" And a communication from the executive, enclosing a resolution adopted by the legislature of Indiana, approving a resolution of Pennsylvania, proposing to amend the constitution of the United States, so as to prohibit congress from passing any law to incorporate any bank or other monied institution, in any part of the United States, except within the District of Columbia; which was read.

The supplement to the act, entitled, An act for the benefit of the infant children of Francis S. Manning, late of Charles county, deceased, was read the second time and passed. On motion by Mr. Hayward, Leave given to bring in a bill, entitled, An act to confirm certain acts of the justices of the peace of Talbot county. Ordered, That Messrs. Hayward, N. Martin and Stevens, report the same.

Mr. Lecompte reports a bill, entitled, A supplement to the act to reduce into one the general acts of assembly respecting elections, and to regulate said elections; which was read.

Mr. Mackey presents a petition from George W. Lightner, of Cecil county, praying a special act of solvency; which was read and referred to Messrs. Mackey, Patton and Maffett.

On motion by Mr. Marriott, the following resolution was read: Resolved, That the treasurer of the western shore pay to the mayor, recorder, aldermen, and common council, of the city of Annapolis, or to their order, the sum of — dollars, to be applied by them to the purchase of a hose engine and buckets, or the benefit and preservation of the public property at the seat of government, and the same when purchased, to be under their care and management, whose duty it shall be to keep the same in complete repair, and provide an engine-house for its reception and protection.

The house resumed the consideration of the Calvert county election. On motion by Mr. Stonestreet, that the name of "Henry Cochran" be stricken out of the resolution?

On motion by Mr. Jenifer, the following order was read: Ordered, That Henry Cochran be called to the bar of the house to answer such questions as may be proposed to him

A motion was made by Mr. Dennis, and the question put, That the following be inserted in said order after the word "Cochran," "and any other witness which any member of this house may deem necessary." Determined in the negative.
