

An act to reduce the salaries of the judges of the city court of Baltimore? Resolved in the affirmative. Ordered, That Messrs. Montgomery, Breckenridge and Boyle, report the same.

On motion by Mr. Dorsey, the following order was read, That the committee of claims be requested to furnish this house with a statement of the different sums which has been or shall be paid for stationary and printing during the present session; the particular items thereof, and to whom paid. On motion by Mr. Montgomery, the words "and also for the sessions of 1817 and 1818 was added," and the order assented to.

The resolution repealing the resolution requiring the several banks to make a report to the legislature, was postponed until the 1st day of July next

Mr. Maffett presents a petition from Jemima Simpess and William Kilgore, praying for the sale of the real estate of Henry Simpess, deceased; which was read and referred to Messrs. Maffett, Mackey and Patten.

Mr. Schnebly presents a petition from Richard M. Daniel, of Washington county, praying a special act of insolvency; which was read and referred to Messrs. Schnebly, Kennedy and Keller.

The supplement to the act, entitled, An act to facilitate the recovery of debts due from the several banks in this state, and to compel the said banks to pay specie for their notes, or forfeit their charter, was read the second time, and the question put, Shall the said bill pass?
