

## VOTES AND PROCEEDINGS

The revenue of Maryland arises from dividends on stock, interest on money loaned, and from miscellaneous branches of revenue, viz: Amerciaments, fines and forfeitures, marriage licenses, ordinary and retailers licenses, hawkers and pedlers licenses, licenses to retailers of dry goods, &c. and from the reports of the treasures of the western and eastern shore, it appears that for the three years ending December 1st 1821, the annual average amount was,
