Ordered, That Messrs. Farquhar, Sappington and Cockey, report the same.

Mr. Kilgour obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, An act to compensate jurors for services therein mentioned. Ordered, That Messrs. Kilgour, Eccleston and Lee, report the same.

Mr. Williams obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, An act to provide for taking the sense of the people of this state on the expediency of calling a convention to reform the constitution of Maryland, and for other purposes. Ordered, That Messrs. Williams, Barnes, Gilpin, Montgomery and Duvall, report the same.

Mr. Speed obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, An act relative to appeal bonds. Ordered, That Messrs. Speed, Perry and Williams, report the same.

Mr. Lee obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, An act to alter and amend the act of assembly authorising the issuing of certificates of freedom to persons of colour. Ordered, That Messrs. Lee, Merrick and M'Culloh, report the same.

Mr. Barnes obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, An act to authorise aliens to purchase and hold real property within this state. Ordered, That Messrs. Barnes, Perry and Potter, report the same.

Mr. Tyson obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, An act to confirm an act to alter and abolish so much of the constitution and form of government of the state of Maryland, as relates to the oath to be taken by the senators and delegates previous to the election of governor and council. Ordered, That Messrs. Tyson, Willson and Potter, report the same.

Mr. Tyson reports the said bill.

On motion by Mr. Willson, the question was put, That leave be given to bring in a bill, entitled, An act to withdraw the donations given to the colleges and academies of this state, for the purpose of making them a part of the school fund of the several counties in which they are respectively situated.
