

Mr. Teackle, from the committee of ways and means, reports a bill, entitled, An act to establish the times of paying the salaries of civil officers.

Mr. Saulsbury reports a bill, entitled, An act for taking lands in execution for payment of debts.

Mr. Perry reports a bill, entitled, An act to make valid the acts of justices of the peace relating to supersedeas.

And Mr. Beckett reports a bill, entitled, An act to authorise the levy court of Calvert county to sell the poor house in said county, and for other purposes.

Mr. Kennedy obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, An act to authorise the sale of tickets in a lottery to be drawn in Virginia for the disposal of the property of Thomas Jefferson, late president of the United States. Ordered, That Messrs. Kennedy, Merrick and Lee, report the same.

On motion by Mr. Shower, Ordered, That the memorial of the Synod of the Reformed Church of the United States, be referred to the committee on vice and immorality, and that the special committee be discharged.

Mr. Grubb obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, A supplement to an act, entitled, A further supplement to an act empowering the levy court of Cecil county, at their discretion, to levy a sum of money to build a bridge over Octorara creek, at or near Samuel Rowland's store, passed December session 1824, chapter 6. Ordered, That Messrs. Grubb, Harlan and Thomas, report the same.

Mr. Mitchell obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, A supplement to an act to amend and reduce into one the several acts of assembly relating to public roads in Worcester county, passed at December session 1821. Ordered, That Messrs. Mitchell, Parker and Samuel R. Smith, report the same.

Mr. Tyson presents a report from the judges of the orphans court of Baltimore county, relative to the condition of the office; referred to the committee of grievances and courts of justice.

On motion by Mr. Williams, That the house proceed to the second reading of the bill relative to internal improvements. Mr. Kennedy moved to postpone the same until Monday next?
