Mr. Lee moved to postpone until to-morrow. Determined in the negative.

The question was then put on striking out. Resolved in the affirma-

tive

The amendment was then agreed to.

Mr. Kennedy moved to strike out of the 4th section the following: president to appoint and dismiss the provost, professors and lecturers; at pleasure; and also the anatomical dissector and demonstrator; Provided always, that in case of a vacancy happening in one of the professorships of the faculties of physic, each of the remaining professors shall have the privilege to nominate two persons; and it shall be the duty of each of the said professors to nominate one person to fill such vacancy, and the said trustees shall appoint some one of the persons thus nominated, to fill such vacancy.

For the purpose of inserting the following: "and in case of a vacancy happening in any of the professorships of either of the faculties, the remaining professors shall have the power to fill such vacancy."

A division was called for, and the question put on striking out. De-

termined in the negative. "

Mr. Kennedy moved to strike out the following section:

And be it enacted. That the said trustees be and they are hereby authorised, to establish new professorships in any of the faculties, and abolish or re-organise old ones if they shall deem it expedient. Determined in the negative.

Mr. Kennedy moved to add the following to the said section: "but the trustees shall not remove any of the present professors, during life,

except they become incapacitated by insanity or old age."

Determined in the negative.

Mr. Kennedy moved to strike out the word 'majority' for the purpose of inserting the words 'two-thirds,' out of the 10th section, which provides that no professor shall be appointed or dismissed, nor any existing professorship abolished or re-organised, or new one established, except by a vote of a majority of the whole number of trustees.

And be it enacted. That it shall be the duty of the board of trustees to make a report to the legislature of all the proceedings under this
