By Mr. Hall, a petition from Charles Adley, a coloured man, of Jefferson county, and state of Virginia, praying the passage of a special act in his favour, allowing him to remove into this state, and to purchase and hold real property therein; referred to Messrs. Hall, Fitzhugh and Farquhar.

By Mr. Norris, a petition from Elizabeth M. Bown, of Harford county, praying relief; referred to Messrs. Norris, Montgomery and Sutton. And also a memorial from sundry citizens of Harford county, counter to an application for the repeal of the law incorporating a company to build a bridge over the Susquehanna river at Havre-de-Grace; referred to the committee already appointed on that subject.

By Mr. Sutton, a petition from sundry inhabitants of Harford county, praying that the levy court of said county may be authorised by law to convey a lot of ground for the purposes therein mentioned; referred to Messrs. Sutton, Hope and Norris.

By Mr. Brown, a petition from Elizabeth Saterfield, of Caroline county, praying pecuniary relief; referred to Messrs. Brown, Saulsbury and Keene.

By Mr. Farquhar, a petition from sundry inhabitants of Frederick county, praying the legislature to devise some ways and means to enable the president, managers, and company, of the Westminster and Hagers Town turnpike road company, to complete said turnpike road; referred to the committee already appointed on that subject. And also a petition from sundry inhabitants of Frederick county, praying that the levy court of said county, may be legally authorised to levy a sum of money to build a bridge over Little Pipe creek, on the post road leading from Frederick to York and Philadelphia; referred to Messrs. Farquhar, Sappington and Barnes.

Mr. Tyson also presented a petition from the trustees of the Male Free School of Baltimore, praying an alteration in their charter; referred to Messrs. Tyson, Stricker and Nicholson.

On motion by Mr. Edward Hughes, the following order was twice read and adopted, viz.

Ordered, That the committee on ways and means be instructed to inquire into the expediency of repealing an act, passed at the last session of the legislature, entitled, A supplement to an act relative to licences, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-four, chapter one hundred and forty-eight, and report thereon to this house.
