rather opposed the murder, but were...
drawn into it by the stronger will of...
the others.

"I shall not oppose the commuta...
tion of the sentence, but all the facts...
mentioned above must be taken into...
consideration by those who will ask...
the Governor to interfere with the...
judgment of the Court, which was...
only pronounced after a fair and im...
partial trial.
