The Art of Carving. Now that "little dinners" and luncheon parties are so popular...

The dish should always be of a good size, and should always be placed so near the carver as to give him or her full control of it.

A fillet of veal should be cut first from the breast, and a breast of veal should be cut next.

A saddle of venison cut thin, even slices from the tail toward the upper part on each side.

Loins of veal, mutton or venison should always be jointed by the butcher before cooking and then they are readily carved.

A leg of mutton should be carved across the middle of the bone first, and then from the thickest part until the grille is reached.

A ham can be served in several ways—by cutting long, delicate slices through the thick fat down to the bone.

For Carving Fish. In carving fish a fish-plate should be used, and if handled with lightness of touch and dexterity the person using it will find very little trouble in carving it.

For Carving Turkey. Turkey should be placed breast up, and the carver should stand to the right of the bird.

For Carving Ham. Ham should be placed on a carving board, and the carver should stand to the right of the ham.

For Carving Roast Beef. Roast beef should be placed on a carving board, and the carver should stand to the right of the beef.

For Carving Lamb. Lamb should be placed on a carving board, and the carver should stand to the right of the lamb.

For Carving Pig. Pig should be placed on a carving board, and the carver should stand to the right of the pig.

For Carving Game. Game should be placed on a carving board, and the carver should stand to the right of the game.
