If the potatoes are small, wash them at once harder, forming a crust on the outside, preventing the escape of water. Potatoes baked in this way are heavy and juicy, indigestible and unpalatable. As soon as the potatoes are soft upon slight pressure of the finger, remove it from the oven. Take it in your hand, wash it with cold water, and carefully work the potato so that you are washing it in the skin, being very careful not to break the skin. When the potato seems soft and tender throughout put it back on the grate in the oven; and so continue until all the potatoes have been subjected to this process.—Ladies' Home Journal.

Improving the Herd.
