

& observed, as well for the Preservation of the Peace, as for the better Government of the People there inhabiting, and publickly to notify the same to all Persons, whom the same doth, or any Way may concern; which Ordinances, Our Pleasure is, shall be observed inviolably within the said Province, under the pains therein to be expressed. So as the said Ordinances be consonant to reason, & be not repugnant nor contrary, but so far as conveniently may be, agreeable with the Laws and Statutes of our Kingdom of *England*, and so as the said Ordinances be not extended, in any Sort to bind, charge, or take away the right or Interest of any Person, or Persons, of, or in their Life, Member, Freehold, Goods, or Chattels.

Furthermore that this new Colony may the more happily encrease by the Multitude of People resorting thither, & may likewise be the more strongly defended from the Incurfions of Salvages, or other Enemies, Pyrates, and Robbers: Therefore we, for us, our Heirs and Successors, do give and grant by these Presents, power, Licence and Liberty unto all the liege-People, & subjects, both present and future, of us, our heirs, & Successors (excepting those who shall be specially forbidden) to transport themselves &
