death, refignations, disqualification, or removal qualification, of the flate, of any of the faid commissioners or treasurement, with the advice of the council, may appoint and commission a sit and proper person to such vacant office, to hold the same until the meeting of the next general assembly.

XV. That the fenate be chosen in the following manner: All persons, qualified as aforesaid to vote for county delegates, shall, on the first Monday of September, seventeen hundred and ninety-six, and on the same day in every fifth year for ever thereafter, elect, viva voce, by a majority of votes, two persons for their respective counties, qualified as aforesaid to be clected county delegates, to be electors of the senate; and the sher if of each county, or in case of sickness, his deputy, (summoning two justices of the county, who are required to attend, for the preservation of the peace,) shall hold and be judge of the said election, which may be adjourned and continued for four days, and no longer, and make return thereof as aforesaid: And all persons, qualified as aforesaid to vote for delegates for the city of Annapolis and Baltimore-town, shall, for the fame first Monday of September, seventeen hundred and ninety-fix, and on the same day in every fifth year for ever thereafter, elect, wive wee, by a majority of votes, one person for the said city and town respectively, qualified as asoresaid to be elefted, a delegate for the said city and town respectively; the faid election to he he'd in the same manner as the election of delegates for the faid city and town, the right to elect the said elector, with respect to Bastimore town, to continue as long as the right to elect elegates for the faid town.
