Legislature is only disabled from being appointed by the Executive to office created during the term for which the Legislature was elected. The disability was only created to prevent improper appointments by the Executive from amongst members of the Legislature, and never was designed to extend to offices elective by the people:

The undersigned therefore concludes by recommending the

adoption of the following resolution, viz:

"Resolved, That in the opinion of this Convention, no person holding a judicial commission under the State of Maryland, is competent to act as a member of this Convention, until he shall have qualified himself by first resigning his said commission."
