

the records of deeds enrolled at length among the records of their respective courts, lists of the alienations of all land thereby granted, bargained or sold, since the 1st day of Jan. 1792, which list shall express the names of the bargainor or grantor, or bargainors or grantors, bargainee or grantee, or bargainees or grantees, of the land, and the quantity of acres the same may contain, and shall enclose and direct the same, under seal, to the commissioners of the tax of the county where such lands may lie, to be forwarded as other public letters are by law directed to be forwarded, and under the like penalties; and the clerks of the general court of the western and eastern shores respectively, shall, annually thereafter, between the 1st day of March and the 1st day of April, in like manner make out, from the records of deeds as aforesaid, lists of the alienations of all lands which shall from time to time be granted, bargained or sold, and recorded, to be directed, delivered and forwarded, in like manner.—1797, c. 89, § 38,

26. The clerks of the general courts of the western and eastern shore, shall make out certificates of the several sums due the jurymen attending the general courts of either shore, expressed in words at length; and the said clerks shall return to the general assembly, on or before the 20th day of Nov. in each year, a true and accurate account of the amount of all certificates so by them issued.—1797, c. 94, § 3.
