

men, labourers or others, hired or employed by such person, or his agent, clerk or other manager.—*ibid.* § 11, and —*ibid.* c. 37, § 28.

6. No retailer shall sell or barter any such spirituous liquor, between the hours of 11 o'clock of every Saturday night, and 5 o'clock of the Monday morning thereafter, under the penalty of 40s. current money for every offence.—*ibid.* § 12, and *ibid.* c. 37, § 29.

7. Any person, not procuring a licence before to retail, may, at any court, other than June or August court, have a licence granted, if the county court shall approve, to continue no longer than the June or August court following, when it shall determine and may be renewed; for taking which licence, the retailer shall pay in proportion to the time between his obtaining such licence and the court aforesaid.—*ibid.* § 13, and *ibid.* c. 37, § 30.

8. Every person applying for licence to retail shall, at the time of granting the same, enter into recognizance to the state, in the sum of 20l. current money, with two sufficient securities, conditioned, that if the person obtaining such licence shall well and truly observe, perform and keep, the several matters and things required by this act, and in every respect conform thereto, then the said recognizance to be void, otherwise of force.—*ibid.* § 14, and *ibid.* c. 37, § 31.

9. 10. No person shall sell or barter any wine, &c. strong beer or cider, on the eastern shore, at any horse race, without a licence for that purpose obtained, under the penalty of 20l. current money for every offence; and any person desirous to obtain such licence, may apply to any justice of the peace, and if he approves of such person, he may direct the clerk of the county to grant licence to such person to sell any such liquors at the horse race specified in such licence, and on obtaining such licence, there shall be paid to the clerk 30s. current money, to be by him paid to the sheriff of the county, and 2s. 6d. to the clerk for his trouble; who shall annually, on or before the 1 day of Oct. transmit a list of such licences, to the treasurer of the eastern shore; and the sheriff shall pay all money by him received, to the said treasurer annually, on or before the 1 day of Oct. and shall remain in his hands, subject to the orders of the visitors, &c. of Washington college.—*ibid.* § 15.

11. No person shall retail any wine, &c. on the western shore, except in the city of Annapolis or the precincts thereof, without a licence obtained agreeably to the directions of this act, on forfeiture of 6l. current money for every such offence; and every person selling any of the articles aforesaid under 10 gallons, shall be deemed a retailer, and no person shall retail less than a pint, but nothing herein contained shall prohibit the maker, distiller or brewer, from retailing the same, not selling less than a quart at any one time.—1784, c. 37, § 24.
