

of controversy, and the demand of a trial thereof by a jury, such proceedings shall be had as are hereinbefore provided, for the trial thereof at the same term, and judgment shall be rendered on the verdict, and an execution awarded, as aforesaid; and no writ of error, *superfedeas*, injunction or appeal, shall be allowed; but this shall not be construed to deprive the parties of their proper remedy upon their contract, if they shall choose to proceed at law or equity upon the same.---*ibid.* § 2.

51. Every sheriff and coroner hereafter commissioned shall, before he be allowed to proceed on the execution of his office, besides the usual oaths or affirmations as required by the constitution and laws of this state, take the oath or affirmation, above prescribed (See *oath of office* art 35) before some judge or justice of the court of the county for which such person may be commissioned, and return a certificate of such oath, &c. to the clerk of the court of the county for which such person may be commissioned, there to be recorded as aforesaid.—1797, c. 87, § 4.

52. The different sheriffs or coroners, shall not, summon as a juror in any case, or return upon a pannel as a juror, any person who may not have arrived to the age of 25 years, and who doth not possess the other qualifications required by the constitution and laws of this state. *ibid.* § 5.

53. The sheriffs shall not permit their deputies, or any of them, to summon any juror or jurors whom they have not directed them to summon; and shall return to their respective county courts a pannel of 48 jurors, qualified as aforesaid.—*ibid.* § 7, 8.
