

C H A P. XXII.

Passed 9th of June, 1692. An ACT for the imposition of four-pence per gallon on liquor imported into this province. Lib. LL. fol. 70. and Lib. WH and L. fol. 143. Repealed 1694, ch. 19.

C H A P. XXIII.

An ACT appointing Peter Pagan, merchant, to be agent for their majesties province of Maryland. Lib. LL. fol. 72. and Lib. WH and L. fol. 145. Repealed 1694, ch. 17.

C H A P. XXIV.

An ACT for the publication of all laws within this province. Lib. LL. fol. 73. Lib. WH and L. fol. 34. and Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 11. Repealed 1704, ch. 77.

C H A P. XXV.

An ACT for the election of sheriffs. Lib. LL. fol. 75. and Lib. WH and L. fol. 35. Repealed 1700, ch. 8.

C H A P. XXVI.

An ACT for securing merchants and others tobacco, after they have received it: Lib. LL. fol. 76. and Lib. WH and L. fol. 31.

For three years, or to the end of the next session. Continued 1694, ch. 16. and 1695, ch. 16 and 26. Expired.

C H A P. XXVII.

An ACT empowering the commissioners of the county courts to levy and raise monies to defray the necessary charges of their counties. Lib. LL. fol. 79. and Lib. WH and L. fol. 33. Repealed 1700, ch. 8.

C H A P. XXVIII.

An ACT declaring what shall be done by the sheriffs *ex officio*. Lib. LL. fol. 80. and Lib. WH and L. fol. 29.

For three years, or to the end of the next session of assembly. Continued 1694, ch. 16. and 1695, ch. 16 and 26. Expired.

C H A P. XXIX.

An ACT concerning the height of fences. Lib. LL. fol. 82. and Lib. WH and L. fol. 30. Repealed 1700, ch. 8.

C H A P. XXX.

An ACT for the enrolment of conveyances, and securing the estates of purchasers. Lib. LL. fol. 83. and Lib. WH and L. fol. 59. Repealed 1700, ch. 8.

N. B. This act is approved by the act of 1715, ch. 47, and all conveyances made under it are thereby confirmed. Sect. 5.

C H A P. XXXI.

An ACT prohibiting arrests upon sabbath days, and days of general muster and training. Lib. LL. fol. 88. and Lib. WH and L. fol. 62. Repealed 1700, ch. 8.

C H A P. XXXII.

An ACT against hog stealers, and marking of hogs. Lib. LL. fol. 90. and Lib. WH and L. fol. 64. Repealed 1700, ch. 8.

C H A P. XXXIII.

An ACT prohibiting trade with the Indians for any flesh dead or alive, except deer or wild fowl. Lib. LL. fol. 94. and Lib. WH and L. fol. 16.

For three years, or to the end of the next session. Continued 1694, ch. 16. and 1695, ch. 16 and 26. Expired.

C H A P. XXXIV.

An ACT for the more speedy bringing to trial, and suppressing criminals, and limiting their punishments for certain offences, when prosecuted in the county courts. Lib. LL. fol. 95. and Lib. WH and L. fol. 17.

For three years, or to the end of the next session. Continued 1694, ch. 16. and 1695, ch. 16 and 26. Expired.

C H A P. XXXV.

An ACT for limitation of certain actions for avoiding suits at law. Lib. LL. fol. 98. Lib. WH and L. fol. 14. and Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 8. Repealed 1704, ch. 77.
