C H A P. LXVII.

An ACT for preventing vexatious and unnecessary suits at law. Lib. LL. fol. 188, and Lib. WH and L. fol. 87. Repealed 1700, ch. 8.

C H A P. LXVIII.

An ACT for encouragement of tillage and raising provisions for advancement of trade within this province. Lib. LL. fol. 191, and Lib. WH and L. fol. 88.

For three years, or to the end of the next session. Continued 1694, ch. 16, and 1695, ch. 16 and 26. Expired.

C H A P. LXIX.

An ACT for recording the journal of the house of assembly. Lib. LL. fol. 193, and Lib. WH and L. fol. 89.

C H A P. LXX.

An ACT for encouragement of such persons as will undertake to build water-mills. Lib. LL. fol. 195, and Lib. WH and L. fol. 98. Repealed 1700, ch. 8.

C H A P. LXXI.

An ACT for naturalization of John Oldson and Matthias Vanderheyden. Lib. LL. fol. 200. Lib. WH and L. fol. 31, and Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 10. A Private Act.

C H A P. LXXII.

An ACT for securing creditors. Lib. LL. fol. 201, and Lib. WH and L. fol. 101. Repealed 1700, ch. 8.

C H A P. LXXIII.

An ACT for the constables taking a list of taxables. Lib. LL. fol. 202, and Lib. WH and L. fol. 102. Repealed 1700, ch. 8.

C H A P. LXXIV.

An ACT against the importation of convicted felons into this province. Lib. LL. fol. 205. Lib. WH and L. fol. 132, and Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 46. Repealed 1704, ch. 77.

C H A P. LXXV.

An ACT against excessive usury. Lib. LL. fol. 207, Lib. WH and L. fol. 133, and Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 37. Repealed 1704, ch. 77.

C H A P. LXXVI.

An ACT directing the manner of electing and summoning delegates and representatives to serve in succeeding assemblies. Lib. LL. fol. 209, Lib. WH and L. fol. 135, and Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 39. Repealed 1704, ch. 77.

C H A P. LXXVII.

An ACT prohibiting foreign engrossers. Lib. LL. fol. 215, and Lib. WH and L. fol. 138.

For three years, and to the end of the next session. Continued 1694, ch. 16, and 1695, ch. 16 and 26. Expired.

C H A P. LXXVIII.

An additional act to the act for regulating ordinaries. Lib. LL. fol. 216, and Lib. WH and L. fol. 138. Repealed 1700, ch. 8.

C H A P. LXXIX.

An ACT concerning negroes and slaves. Lib. LL. fol. 220, and Lib. WH and L. fol. 21.

For three years, or to the end of the next assembly. Continued 1694, ch. 16, and 1695, ch. 16. Expired.

C H A P. LXXX.

An ACT for restraining the unreasonable increase of horses in this province. Lib. LL. fol. 225, and Lib. WH and L. fol. 25. Repealed 1694, ch. 17.

C H A P. LXXXI.

An ACT for the payment of fees due from criminal persons. Lib. LL. fol. 227, and Lib. WH and L. fol. 36. Repealed 1700, ch. 8.
