An ACT concerning those servants that have bastards. Repealed 1700, ch. 8.

C H A P. XXVI.

An ACT against striking of fish in Dorchester and Somerset counties. Repealed 1696, ch. 15.

C H A P. XXVII.

An ACT for easement of the inhabitants of this province in testamentary affairs. Repealed 1700,

An ACT for relief of debtors. Repealed 1700, ch. 8.

An ACT for settling assemblies and provincial courts, and erecting a court-house at Anne-Arundel-

A Supplementary act to the act for encouragement of such persons as will undertake to build water-

An ACT for the assessment of the public charge of this province.
