C H A P. XXXV.
An ACT for the naturalization of Daniel Danifon, senior, and Daniel Danifon, junior, of Calvert county. Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 83. A Private Act. Passed 1st of March, 1694.

C H A P. XXXVI.
An ACT for reviving certain laws.

At a SESSION of ASSEMBLY, begun and held at the PORT of ANNAPOLIS, the 8th day of May, in the 7th year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord and Lady WILLIAM and MARY, by the Grace of God, of England, Scotland, France and Ireland, King and Queen, Defenders of the Faith, &c. *annoque domini* 1695, and ended the 22d day of the same month, the following acts were made. 1695.

C H A P. I.
An additional act to the act for religion. Repealed 1696, ch. 18.

C H A P. II.
An ACT for settling Anne-Arundel county court at the port of Annapolis, within the same county. Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 84. Passed 22d of May, 1695.

C H A P. III.
An ACT for securing executors and administrators from double paying of debts, and limiting the time for payment of obligations within this province. Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 85. Repealed 1704, ch. 77.

C H A P. IV.
An additional act to the act for better administration of justice in probat of wills, granting of administrations, recovering of legacies, and securing of filial portions.
For three years, or to the end of the next session. Continued 1695, ch. 26. Expired.

C H A P. V.
An ACT for regulating of ordinaries, and limiting the number of them within this province. Repealed 1700, ch. 8.

C H A P. VI.
An ACT restraining the frequent assembling of negroes within this province.
For three years, or to the end of the next session. Continued 1695, ch. 26. Expired.

C H A P. VII.
An additional act to the act for ports. Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 88.

C H A P. VIII.
An ACT for the raising a supply towards defraying the public charges of this province. Expired.
