C H A P. XXVII.

An ACT for securing the frontiers of this province from the incursions of Indians. Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 254.

C H A P. XXVIII.

An ACT prohibiting the inhabitants of this province, or any others, from carrying liquors to the Indian towns. Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 256. Repealed 1704, ch. 77.

C H A P. XXIX.

An ACT for summoning grand and petit juries. Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 257.

C H A P. XXX.

An ACT for taking special bail in the several counties of this province upon actions and suits depending in his majesty's provincial courts. Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 260. Repealed 1704, ch. 77.

C H A P. XXXI.

An ACT for the constables taking a list of taxables. Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 263. Repealed 1704, ch. 77.

C H A P. XXXII.

An ACT for the due recording of all laws of this province in the secretary's office, and also transmitting the journal of the house of delegates into the secretary's office. Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 267. Repealed 1704, ch. 77.

C H A P. XXXIII.

An ACT for securing merchants and others tobacco after they have received it. Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 268. Repealed 1704, ch. 77.

C H A P. XXXIV.

An ACT for securing the parochial libraries of this province, and that the care and charge thereof be committed to some worthy and learned person. Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 269. Repealed 1704, ch. 77.

C H A P. XXXV.

An ACT for regulating of ordinaries, and limittting the number of them within this province. Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 278. Expired.

C H A P. XXXVI.

An ACT for punishment of blasphemy, fornication, adultery, profane cursing and swearing. Lib. LL. No. 2. fol. 278. Repealed 1704, ch. 77.
