An ACT for confirming the last wills and testaments of Charles Ashcome, late of St. Mary's county, gentleman, deceased, and of John Whinfell, of Calvert county, planter, deceased, and likewise of John Burnam, late of Talbot county, deceased. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 174. A Private Act.
