C. H. A. P. XI.

An ACT to allow the importation of bread, flour and Indian corn, from the end of this session of Assembly to the end of the next session. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 393. Expired. Passed 11th of Nov. 1709.

C. H. A. P. XII.

An ACT reviving and continuing an act of assembly of this province, entitled (a) An act for the ordering and regulating the militia of this province, for the better security and defence thereof, and for supplying some defects therein. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 393. (a) 1704, ch. 87, hereby continued two years.

C. H. A. P. XIII.

An ACT reviving and continuing of all process and proceedings in St. Mary's county court, Dorchester county court, Baltimore county court, from the first and second Tuesdays of November, 1709, to the last Tuesday of the same month. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 394.

C. H. A. P. XIV.

An ACT to repeal a certain clause of one act, entitled, (b) An act ascertaining fees to attorneys and practitioners of the law in the courts of this province, and for levying the same by way of execution. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 395. (b) 1708, ch. 8, which is repealed.

C. H. A. P. XV.

An ACT reviving an act, entitled, (c) An act for limitation of officers fees. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 396. (c) 1704, ch. 86, hereby continued for two years.

C. H. A. P. III.

An ACT for securing persons rights to town lands. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 401. Repealed 1715, ch. 49, and 1719, ch. 16.
