An ACT empowering certain trustees to sell and value a certain tract of land, lying in Dorchester county, called Richardson's Choice, formerly the land of John Nichols, and by him sold to William Edmondson. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 402. A Private Act.

**C H A P. V.**  
An ACT for the building a court-house for Talbot county, at Armstrong's old fields, near Pitt's bridge. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 403.

**C H A P. VI.**  
An ACT continuing St. Mary's county court at the new court-house built at Seymour-town, otherwise Sheppard old fields. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 404.

**C H A P. VII.**  
An ACT for continuing the county court of Queen-Anne's county at Queen's-town, where the court-house now stands. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 405.

**C H A P. VIII.**  
An ACT confirming the last will and testament of Richard Bridges, late of Talbot county, deceased. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 405. A Private Act.

**C H A P. IX.**  
An ACT for the sale of Talbot county old court-house and prison, and land thereto belonging. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 405.

**C H A P. X.**  
An ACT for the payment and assessment of the public charge of this province. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 406.

**C H A P. XI.**  
An ACT reviving an act, entitled, (a) An act prohibiting the importation of bread, beer, flour, malt, wheat, or other English or Indian grain or meal, horses, mares, colts or fillies, from Pennsylvania, and the territories thereunto belonging. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 406.

An ACT for confirmation of the last will and testament of William Dixon, late of Talbot county, glover, deceased. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 407. A Private Act.

**C H A P. XIII.**  
An ACT reviving an act, entitled, (b) An act for killing wolves and crows. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 407.

**C H A P. XIV.**  
An ACT reviving an act, entitled, (c) An act for relief of poor debtors, and ascertaining the manner of tenders in tobacco. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 408.

**C H A P. XV.**  
An ACT reviving an act, entitled, (d) An act of directions for the sheriff's office in this province, and for the more easy payment of the public and county levy. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 408.

**C H A P. XVI.**  
An ACT for the naturalization of Christian Swormstead, of Calvert county, chirurgeon. Lib. LL. No. 3. fol. 408. A Private Act.
