

C H A P. V.

An ACT empowering the justices of Cecil county court to levy on the taxable inhabitants of St. Stephen's, North-Sassafras parish, the sum of two hundred and eighty pounds current money of Maryland, at two equal assessments. Lib. BLC. fol. 173. Passed 28th of May, 1737.

C H A P. VI.

An ACT to empower the justices of St. Mary's county court to purchase land whereon to build a prison. Lib. BLC. fol. 174.

C H A P. VII.

A Supplementary act to the act, entitled, * An act for the more effectual punishment of negroes and other slaves, and for taking away the benefit of clergy from certain offenders, and to an act, entitled, † An act to prevent the tumultuous meeting and other irregularities of negroes and other slaves, and directing the manner of trying of slaves. Lib. BLC. fol. 175. * 1729, ch. 24. † 1723, ch. 15.

This act was passed for three years, &c. and continued by 1740, ch. 7, 1744, ch. 18, and 1747, ch. 16. Expired.

An ACT to encourage the apprehending some felons, and for trying accessaries to felonies by them committed before conviction of the principals. Lib. BLC. fol. 178.

C H A P. IX.

An ACT for the relief of William Torvor, of London, merchant. Lib. BLC. fol. 179. A Private Act.

C H A P. X.

A Supplementary act to the act, entitled, * An act for erecting a town in Kent county, on the south side of Sassafras river, on a tract of land called Tolchester, at the place where the ferry is now kept. Lib. BLC. fol. 180. * 1736, ch. 21.

A Supplementary act to the act for erecting a town at Joppa, in Baltimore county. Lib. BLC. fol. 181.

An ACT to cut off the entail of two acres of land, part of a tract called New-Year's-Gift. Lib. BLC. fol. 182.

A Supplementary act to the act, entitled, (a) An act for the speedy and more effectual publication of the laws of this province, and for the encouragement of William Parks, of the city of Annapolis, printer. Lib. BLC. fol. 183.
