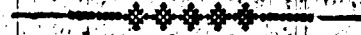

At a SESSION of ASSEMBLY begun and held at the City of ANNAPOLIS, the 23d day of April, in the 25th year of the dominion of the right honourable CHARLES, absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon, Lord Baron of Baltimore, &c. *annoque domini* 1740, and ended the 5th day of June following, in the 26th year of his Lordship's dominion, the following law was enacted, viz.

C H A P. I.

Passed 3d of June 1740.

An ACT for issuing and paying out of the office of the commissioners or trustees for emitting bills of credit, established by act of assembly, the sum of two thousand five hundred and sixty-two pounds ten shillings current money in bills of credit, to be applied for the encouragement of persons voluntarily enlisting themselves in his majesty's service.
