

C H A P. II.

An ACT for laying out and applying a sum, not exceeding two hundred and fifty pounds current money, to the uses therein mentioned. Lib. BLC. fol. 216. Passed 22d of June, 1741.

C H A P. III.

An ACT to cut off the entail of a parcel of land, called Roper's Neck, and to enable Benjamin Howard to convey the same in fee in exchange for other lands. Lib. BLC. fol. 216. A Private Act.

C H A P. IV.

An ACT for the relief of John Blandford, and Hannah Ratcliff. Lib. BLC. fol. 217. A Private Act.

C H A P. V.

An ACT for the continuance of Baltimore county court, Cecil county court, Kent county court, and Queen-Anne's county court, from the first, third and fourth Tuesdays in June next, until the first, third and fourth Tuesdays in August next. Lib. BLC. fol. 218.

C H A P. VI.

An ACT empowering the three commissioners herein mentioned, together with the justices of Calvert county, to repair the court-house of that county, by an assessment on the inhabitants thereof. Lib. BLC. fol. 219.

C H A P. VII.

An ACT empowering the justices of Prince-George's county to levy on the taxable inhabitants of Queen-Anne parish, in the said county, the sum of one hundred pounds current money of Maryland, for the uses therein mentioned. Lib. BLC. fol. 219.

C H A P. VIII.

An ACT for the cutting off the entail, and investing an estate of inheritance in fee-simple, in part of a tract of land called Cooper's Purchase, in Thomas Spalding and Catherine his wife, and to entail other lands, lying in St. Mary's county, in lieu thereof. Lib. BLC. fol. 220. A Private Act.

C H A P. IX.

An ACT investing Archibald Douglass, of Cecil county, son and heir of William and Mary Douglass, deceased, with an estate in fee-simple in the one moiety of a tract of land called The Level, or Scutt's Level, lying in Baltimore county. Lib. BLC. fol. 221. A Private Act.

C H A P. X.

An ACT to cut off and bar the entail of part of a certain tract of land called William's Range, in Prince-George's county, and to settle other lands in lieu thereof. Lib. BLC. fol. 222. A Private Act.

C H A P. XI.

An ACT for the relief of Nicholas Hammond, Peter Topping, Edward Cowley, Henry Templeman, William Bafoot, Anne Rind, widow, and Mary Penn, languishing prisoners in Anne-Arundel county gaol, Joseph Maclester, a languishing prisoner in Somerset county gaol, and Patrick Mackey, a languishing prisoner in Cecil county gaol. An ACT for the relief of Charles Sewall, of St. Mary's county, Esquire, and other purposes therein mentioned. Lib. BLC. fol. 227.
