

THOMAS BLADEN, ESQUIRE, GOVERNOR. NOVEMBER 1746.
 At a SESSION of ASSEMBLY begun and held at the City of ANNAPOLIS, the 6th, and ended the 12th day of November, in the 32d year of the dominion of the right honourable CHARLES, absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon, Lord Baron of Baltimore, &c. *annoque domini* 1746, the following law was enacted.

THOMAS BLADEN, ESQUIRE, GOVERNOR.

An ACT for issuing and paying out of the office of the commissioners or trustees for emitting bills of credit, established by act of assembly, the sum of nine hundred pounds current money in bills of credit, as also for the payment of two hundred pounds sterling money for purchasing provisions for his majesty's forces raised in this province, and other purposes, and for continuing part of an act therein mentioned. Lib. BLC. fol. 353. Passed 12th of Nov. 1746.

At a SESSION of ASSEMBLY begun and held at the City of ANNAPOLIS, the 16th day of May, in the 32d year of the dominion of the right honourable CHARLES, absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon, Lord Baron of Baltimore, &c. and ended the 11th day of July, in the 33d year of his lordship's dominion, *annoque domini* 1747, the following laws were enacted.

CHAPTER I.

An ACT for amending the staple of tobacco, for preventing frauds in his majesty's customs, and for the limitation of officers fees. Lib. BLC. fol. 357. Passed 11th of July, 1747.
 To be in force from the 1st December, 1748, for five years. Expired.

CHAPTER II.

An ACT for trial of all matters of fact in the several counties where they have arisen or shall arise. Lib. BLC. fol. 394.
 To be in force till the 1st November, 1749. Expired.

CHAPTER III.

An ACT to remedy some proceedings in the court of Charles county, and to prevent the removal of the records from the public offices. Lib. BLC. fol. 400.

The 9 first sections of this act having ceased to have any operation are omitted.

X. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, by and with the authority, advice and consent aforesaid, That for Books not to be the future no clerk or register within this province, (except parish registers,) shall at any time here- removed, &c. after,
