C H A P. XVI.

An ACT for the relief of fundry infolvent debtors confined in Baltimore county gaol. Lib. TBH. Palled 20th of No. B. fol. 98. A Private Act.

C H A P. XVII.

An ACT for the inspection of salted provisions exported and imported from and to the town of Baltimore. Lib. TBH. No. B. fol. 99.

HEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, that great impositions daily arise from Preamble. the exportation and fale of unfound falted provisions, and there not being any regulations for the prevention of fuch frauds; therefore;

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the commissioners of Baltimore- Commissioners town, or the major part of them, shall meet between the first and twentieth days of March next, to meet, &c. and between the first and twentieth days of March yearly, and every year thereafter, during the continuance of this act, and then nominate and appoint a person of bod repute, and skilful in the goodness, quality, and well curing of salted beef, pork, and fills of every kind, to be inspector of falted provisions within the faid town, for the year-ensuing.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That every commissioner, who shall vote for the said officer, shall take Their oath the following oath before he shall proceed to the nomination and appointment of the said officer: " I, A.-B. do swear, that I will faithfully, honestly and impartially, nominate and appoint such per-" son to be inspector of salted provisions within the said town as I think in my judgment and con-" science is fit and capable of executing the said office."

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That in case of the death of such officer so appointed, or his resusal How vacancies or neglect to act, the faid commissioners, or the major part of them, shall, as soon as conveniently are to be filled. may be thereafter, meet together and appoint one other such person as asoresaid, in the stead of the person so dying, or resuling or neglecting to act, for the residue of the year; and if the said commisfioners fliall neglect and omit to nominate and appoint such officer, then the governor and council may appoint such officer, who shall be qualified agreeably to the directions of this act, and have the like power and authority as if he had been by the faid commissioners nominated and appointed.

V. AND BE IT ENACTED, That all falted beef, pork, and fish of every kind, brought or imported Beef. &c. to be into the said town, from any part of this state, or any one of the United States, or from any foreign made merport whatever, from and after the first day of April next, shall be made merchantable, found, and chantable, &c. fit for ule.

VI. AND BE IT ENACTED, That from and after the first day of November next, all beef and pork Barrels to be barrels brought to, or imported into, Baltimore-town, from any part of this state, shall be made of made of good good seasoned materials, well made, tightened with twelve hoops, sufficiently nailed with four nails in each chine hoop, and three nails in each upper bulge hoop, sufficient to hold pickle, and of the following dimensions, viz. the staves to be of the length of twenty-nine inches, and eighteen inches diameter at the head; all fish barrels imported or brought in as aforefaid, shall be made of good feafoned materials, well made, tightened with twelve hoops, sufficiently nailed in manner aforesaid, fufficient to hold pickle, and of the following dimensions, to wit: the staves of the length of twentyeight inches, and eighteen inches diameter at the head-

VII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That all persons packing and curing beef or pork as aforesaid, shall Quantity to be put in the faid barrels the full quantity of two hundred and twenty pounds net weight; and that if put in each barany person or persons shall pack any beef or pork barrel with a less quantity than is directed by this act to be contained in the barrels of the fize and dimensions aforefaid, he or they shall forseit, if the deficiency be three pounds, fix-pence current money, if fix pounds, one shilling and fix-pence, and fix-pence per pound for every pound deficient above fix pounds.

VIII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That all and every barrel of beef, pork and fish, brought to the said To be viewed, town for fale or exportation, shall be submitted to the view and examination of the inspector, so as &c. aforefaid nominated and appointed, who shall fearch and try the same by opening one of the heads, and examining whether it be honeftly and well packed, and also whether it be found, good, and of fufficient weight; and if the faid inspector shall judge the same to be merchantable, according to the directions of this act, he shall brand every such barrel on the quarter with the word Baltimore, with
