HEREAS Thomas Beatty, theriff of Frederick county, hath not executed, or undertaken to Preamble. V.V. execute, any of the powers conferred on him by the act, * entitled, An act to enable the 1789, ch. 65. securities of Christopher Edelen, deceased; and his administrators, to collect the balances due to him as collector of the taxes, and theriff, of Frederick county, fo that the balances due to the faid Chriftopher Edelen as collector and theriff aforefaid yer remain unpaid; and it appearing to this general assembly just and proper that the remedy by way of execution should be pursued for the benefit of the securities, creditors and representatives, of the said Christopher Edelen,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the securities, or such of them as Securities to are or may be living, and the administrators of the faid Christopher Edelen, are hereby empowered appoint a perto appoint, in writing, a fit and proper person to receive and collect all monies due and owing to the faid Christopher Edelen, as theriff and collector aforesaid, under such allowance or commission a. they may think proper and agree for, which person so appointed shall have the like power and authority to receive, collect and execute for, the arrears or balances due, as the faid Christopher Edelen at any time had as theriff and collector aforefaid, and the like power and remedy to fettle with the deputies of the faid Christopher Edelen, and to compel payment of any balance due from them, as the faid Christopher Edelen had at any time in his life-time; and the money, when the same shall be collected, shall be applied and paid as the said Christopher Edelen, on his receipt thereof, ought to have applied and paid the fame, and the balance, if any, shall be considered as the personal estate of the said Christopher Edelen, and disposed of as such; and the said securities and administrators may take fuch bond and security of the person by them employed as they may think proper, and fuch person may appoint others under him, with like powers as are given to him by this act, to make the collection more speedy and effectual; provided, that nothing in this act shall discharge the faid securities or administrators, and that no greater commission than six per cent. for collection shall be allowed against the estate of the said Christopher Edelen.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That on the interest being duly paid upon the balance due to this state Interest being from the faid Christopher Edelen, no fuit or process shall issue against the faid administrators or securities of the faid Christopher Edelen on his bonds, or for the recovery of the balance due to the public from him, before the first day of September next.

IV. And BE IT ENACTED, That the faid act of affembly to empower Thomas Beatty to collect Anadrepealed. the arrearages of the taxes due to the estate of Christopher Edelen, late of Frederick county, deceased, as collector for the faid county for the years therein mentioned, be and is hereby repealed.
