C H A P. XXIII.

An ACT to lay out several turnpike roads in Baltimore county. Passed 21st of May, 1787. Lib. TBH. No. B. fol. 223.

Supplementary and other acts 1790, ch. 22, 1795, ch. 45, 1796, ch. 44, 1797, ch. 105, 1798, ch. 53.

WHEREAS the public roads leading from Baltimore-town to the western parts of this state, by Preamble means of the great number of waggons that use the same, are rendered almost impassable during the winter season, and the ordinary method of repairing the said roads is not only insufficient, but exceedingly burthensome; and the establishment of several turnpike roads in the said county would, greatly reduce the price of land carriage, of produce and merchandife, and raife the value of the land in the laid county, and confiderably increase the commerce of the state;

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That John Ellicott, Edward Norwood A road to be and Thomas Hollingsworth, and any two of them, shall be and are hereby appointed commissioners laid out from Baltimore towards Frederick-town.

Baltimore toto examine, furvey, lay out and mark, a public road from Baltimore-town towards Frederick-town, Baltimore to-in Frederick county, to the line of Baltimore county, fixty-fix feet wide, and on as streight a line rick-town, &c. from Baltimore-town to Frederick-town as the nature of the country will permit; and the said commiffioners are to confider not only the distance but the situation and goodness of the ground on which the faid road is to pass; provided, that the faid road shall not be carried through any building, orchard, garden or yard, without the confent of the owner or possessor thereof.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That Charles Carnan, Robert Lyon and Henry Willson, and any two To Reister'sof them, shall be and are hereby appointed commissioners to examine, survey, lay out and mark, a town. public road from Baltimore-town to Reister's town, in the said county, of the width aforesaid, and in the manner aforefaid.

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That Charles Walker, Cornelius Howard and Richard Owings, or From Reister's. any two of them, shall be and are hereby appointed commissioners to examine, survey, lay out and town to Winmark, a public road from Reister's-town aforesaid to Winchester-town, of the width aforesaid, and in the manner aforefaid.

V. AND BE IT ENACTED, That Nathan Cromwell, Electius Lemmon and George Nace, or any Towards Hatwo of them, shall be and are hereby appointed commissioners to examine, survey, lay out and mark, nover-town. a public road from Reister's town aforesaid towards Hanover-town to the line of Baltimore county, of the width aforesaid, and in manner aforesaid.

VI. AND BE IT ENACTED, That Benjamin Griffith, Elijah Merryman, Richard Johns, Thomas From Balti-Gift and William Gwinn, or any three of them, shall be and are hereby appointed commissioners to more towards York-town. examine, survey, lay out and mark, a public road from Baltimore-town towards York-town to the line of Baltimore county, of the width aforefaid, and in manner aforefaid.
