aforefaid, or forfeit as aforefaid for refusing to accept and take upon him the fame, and that no judge of the general court, county magiltrate or theriff, or any one who hath not the qualification to be a member of the general affembly, if elected, shall be capable to be cholen or act as a trustee aforesaid, nor shall any person be compellable to serve in less than three years after he has served, or paid the faid forfeiture for not ferving as a truffee aforefaid.

VI. AND, for enabling the faid trustees to purchase land, and erect an alms and work-house in the faid county, BE IT ENACTED, That the faid trustees, or the major part of them, be and they Trustees to are hereby authorised and empowered, from time to time, as occasion shall require, to draw upon the draw, &c. collector of Kent county for all or any part of the money by this act affelfed, levied and collected, as shall remain in his hands, which the said trustees, or the major part of them, shall think necessary for the uses and purposes mentioned in this act.

VII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid trustees, or the major part of them, appointed as afore- To purchase faid, shall and they are hereby authorised, directed and required, to buy and purchase, in fee-simple, land, &c. a quantity of land in the faid county, not exceeding thirty acres, or less than fix; and the faid trustees, or the major part of them, appointed as aforesaid, are hereby authorised, directed and required, to agree and contract with a workman or workmen to undertake, erect, build, and in a workman-like manner to complete and finish, on the said land when so-purchased, good, strong, sufficient and convenient houses, habitations and dwellings, for the reception of the poor of said county, and of such vagrants, beggars, vagabonds and other offenders, as shall be committed by virtue of this act, and they shall appropriate one part thereof to be called the alms-house, to and for the reception and lodging of the poor of the faid county, and another part or parts thereof to be called the work-house, to and for the reception and lodging of all fuch vagrants, beggars, vagabonds and other offenders, as shall be committed by virtue of this act; and the aforesaid land when bought, and the aforesaid houses, habitations and dwellings, when built, shall be, and they are hereby enacted and declared to be, vested in the said trustees, and their successors, for ever, as their estate and inheritance, for the uses and purposes by this act directed and expressed.

VIII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid trustees, or the major part of them, sliall, and they And buy beds, are hereby authorised, directed and required, after the houses, habitations and dwellings aforesaid, shall be completely erected and finished, to buy and purchase, for the use and employment of the poor of the faid county, and the vagrants, beggars, vagabonds and other offenders, who shall be committed by virtue of this act, fufficient beds, bedding, working tools, kitchen utenfils, cows, horses, and other necessaries; and the faid trustees are hereby directed and required to purchase the said quantity of land not exceeding thirty acres, or less than fix, in such part of said county as they, or a majority of them, may think most convenient; and the faid trustees are hereby directed and required to keep a fair, distinct, and clear account, in writing, of all the monies by them received and expended by virtue of this act, and to return a true copy thereof, and shew and produce the vouchers to support the fame, to the justices of the said county, at their June court yearly, to be by the said justices inspected and examined, which faid accounts shall be lodged with the clerk of the faid court.

IX. AND BE IT ENACTED, That after the expiration of the faid three years, the justices of Kent Justices to levy county court aforesaid for the time being shall and they are hereby empowered to assess and levy on all money, &c. the property in faid county subject and liable to assessment, at the time of laying their county rate, a fum of current money not exceeding five shillings on every hundred pounds of property as aforesaid, in the faid county, together with the collector's commission of fix per cent. for collecting the same; which faid affessment shall be made, levied, collected and paid, in the same manner as herein before is directed; which faid money, when fo as aforesaid collected, shall be paid by the collector to the order of such trustees, or the major part of them, under their common seal, who are hereby authorifed and required to receive and apply the fame to and for the use, benefit and charge, of maintaining the poor, vagrants, beggars, vagabonds and other offenders, in the purchasing provisions and other necessaries for use and labour, in paying a doctor for his salary and for medicines, in providing men and women fervants to be under the direction and management of the overfeer of fuch alms and work-house hereafter directed to be appointed, for and in purchasing materials for the use and employment of all the poor, and all beggars, vagrants, vagabonds and other offenders, who shall be able to work, and who shall be committed by virtue of this act.

X. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid trustees, or the major part of them, shall and they are Trustees to hereby authorised, directed and enjoined, to meet together between the first and tenth day of No- meet really, vember yearly, and all fuch other times as they shall judge necessary, at the alms and work-house
