ceiver; collector, or others to concerned as aforefaid, and make and deliver to them, upon their respective; paths, true and persect copies, and extracts thereof, for the purpose of settling and adjusting all accounts; claims and demands, relative to the arrearages aforelaid, and to enable the laid Robert Peter, John Murdock, William Deakius, junior, Bernard Oneale, Edward Burgels, Walter Smith and Richard Thompson, or a majority of them, to make a full and perfect collection of the said public affeliment arising in the year at relaid, and still remaining due in the county aforefaid.

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That upon the neglect or refusal of any deputy, agent, receiver, col- Upon neglect, lector, or person to appointed or acting as fucht during the year aforesaid, or afterwards, under the &c commissions faid John Hayman Nichols, or in his name, or by virtue of his authority, to fulfil and comply with ers may adjust accounts, &c. the directions of this act, the commissioners of the tax for Montgomery county be and they are hereby empowereds on hearing, (or default to appear on notice,) to adjust the accounts standing between the faid John Hayman-Nichols as collector aforefaid, and all and every his faid deputies, agents, receivers, collectors, or persons acting as such during the year aforelaid, or fince, and may order the balance to be paid to the faid Robert Peter, John Murdock, William Deakins, junior, Bernard Oneale, Edward Burgefs, Walter Smith and Richard Thompson, or a majority of them, either immediately, or by a fhort day to be limitted, and may carry fuch order into effect by their warrant directed to the theriff to levy the Jum due, in the same manner as by fieri facias, on the lands, goods or chattels, of the faid deputy, agent, receiver or collector, or perion acting as such during the year aforefaid, or fince, under the faid John Hayman Nichols, or by virtue of his authority, or otherwile, or take his or their body in execution, as on a capias ad satisfaciendum, in satisfaction thereof.

V. And BE IT ENACTED, That the faid Robert Peter, John Murdock, William Deakins, junior, Commission al-Bernard Oneale, Edward Burgels, Walter Smith and Richard Thompson, or a majority of them, owed. shall have and be allowed the same commissions upon the collection of the residue of said taxes, where the said John Hayman Nichols has not already been allowed commission on the settlement of his accounts by the commissioners of the tax for the county aforesaid, for their trouble and expence of making the fame, to which the faid John Hayman Nichols was or would have been entitled to as collector by the laws of this state, had he made the collection thereof.

VI. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the commissioners of the tax for the county aforesaid be autho- Commissioners rifed and empowered, upon application of the faid Robert Peter, John Murdock, William Deakins, junior, Bernard Oneale, Edward Burgels, Walter Smith and Richard Thompson, or a majority of them, to fettle and adjust their accounts, and, if necessary, to make them such allowance thereon as may appear just and reasonable, for paupers or insolvents, and give them a certificate thereof, containing the amount of such allowance; provided, that the said commissioners shall not allow the said collectors any deduction as aforefaid, except only in fuch cafes where it shall appear to them that the faid John Hayman Nichols, or the collectors, have used all lawful means for levying and collecting the fame.

WIL AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid public dues and taxes remaining due as aforefaid in Taxes to be to the fail county, shall, when collected, be to the only use and benefit of the said counter securities, the use of counfo far as may be necessary for their indemnity.
