take bond, which the faid overfeer, and any other overfeer to be appointed, fliall and is hereby obliged to enter into, with good and lufficient furcties, in the penalty of two hundred pounds current money, payable to the faid truffees of the poor, conditioned as follows, to wit: "The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bound A. B. as overfeer of the alms and work-house in Montgomery or Harford county, as the case may be, shall well and truly discharge his duty in the faid station, and more particularly according to the directions of the act of allembly, entitled, An act for the relief of the poor in Montgomery and Harford counties, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in law."

XI. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid truftees respectively, or a major part of them, shall and May remove they are hereby directed and empowered to remove such overseer, and all other officers by them to be overseers, &c. appointed in pursuance of this act, at their discretion, and to choose others in their place and stead.

XII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid truftees, or the major part of them, Wall and And meet four they are hereby directed and enjoined to meet at the alms and work-houle in their faid counties times a year, man har times in the year win the first week in lanuary May August and Manager on an respectively four times in the year, in the first week in January, May, August and November, or oftener, if it should by them be deemed necessary, to make and ordain, by a majority of votes of such as may be prefent, all fuch good and wholesome ordinances, rules and by-laws, as they shall think convenient and necessary for the direction, government and support, of the alms and work-house in their county, and alfo for the cleanlinels, maintenance and employment of all fuch poor persons as shall be taken under their care, and of all vagrants; beggars, vagabonds and offenders, that shall be committed thereto by virtue of this act; all which ordinances, rules and by-laws, shall be from time to time inviolably observed by all persons concerned, according to the tenor and effect thereof.

XIII AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid overfeer shall keep a fair and regular lift of all poor, Oveffeer to and of all beggars, vagrants, vagabonds and offenders, who shall be committed to his faid alms and work-house, and also fair and regular accounts in writing of all materials and other things coming to his hands as overfeer aforefaid, and of all expences and charges attending their maintenance and support, and of all monies received by him for the sale of the produce of their labour, and otherwife, as overfeer aforefaid, and shall lay the faid lifts and accounts before the trustees of his county, or the major part of them, at their meetings at the times by this act directed, or oftener, if by them required.

XIV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid overfeer may compel and oblige any of the faid poor, And compel beggars, vagrants and vagabonds, or offenders, in his alms and work-house, if of a sufficient work see ability, to work and labour, and the produce of their labour he is hereby directed and empowered to fell, and apply the money arising from such sale to their maintenance and support.

XV: AND BE IT ENACTED, That upon complaint made, that any person, from his or her disor- Disorderly perderly conduct, gives disturbance to his or their neighbourhood, and is likely to become chargeable to fons may be committed the faid county respectively, it shall and may be lawful for any one magistrate of the said county, if upon hearing the party he shall judge the complaint to be well founded, to commit such disorderly perfon, reliding within the faid county respectively, to the said work-house, for any time not exceeding three months, unless he or she shall find security, at the discretion of the magistrate aforesaid, in any fum not exceeding ten pounds current money, for his or her good behaviour during the space of fix months; and also upon complaint and due proof made by the overfeer of the faid alms and workhouse to any one trustee, that any person in the work-house hath behaved and demeaned him. or herfelf in a diforderly manner, or hath refused or neglected to do and perform his or her daily labour and talk, or hath refused or neglected to obey, keep and observe, any of the ordinances, rules and by laws, of the faid corporation, to order and direct such moderate and proper correction, not exceeding fifteen lafties for any one offence, to be given to fuch offender, as the nature of the cafe may require.

XVI. AND BE IT ENACTED, That it shall and may be lawful to and for any of the faid trustees to direct and appoint under their hand in writing what poor shall be received into the alms and work-house med what poor of their county; and it fliall and may be lawful for any one justice of the peace for the faid counties, and ceived, &c. for any person authorised and appointed by such justice, to apprehend, or cause to be apprehended and committed to the faid work-house, any vagrants, vagabonds, beggars, and other idle, dissolute, and diforderly perfore, found loitering or reliding in their faid county, who follow no labour, trade, occupation or business, and to have no wisble means of subsistence whereby to acquire an honest livelihood, there to be kept at hard labour for any time not exceeding three months, and the overfeer of
