IV. AND BE IT ENACTED. That the leafe or leafes aforefaid shall be figned by the clerk of faid C H A P. court; under the direction of the justices aforelaid, which, shall be valid in law; and the faid clerk Leafes to be fhall enter a copy of all fuch leafe or leafes, and proceedings relative to the prifon land aforefaid, on figued, bc. the land records of Dorchester county, and a reasonable compensation shall be allowed him in the county levy, by the justices aforefaid, for recording faid leafes and proceedings.

V. And BE IT ENACTED, That in case of non-compliance of the parties who purchase leases of Justices may faid lands of the justices aforefaid, that the faid justices and their successors fliall have full power to bring suit, &c. bring fuit, or fuits against the delinquent purchasers, or to recover payment for the annual rents by suit, or by distress and sale of the property sound on the premises.

VI. AND BE IT, ENACTED, That all money ariling from fuch fales and ground-rents fliall go to How money is the credit of faid county in discharge of so much of the public levy of faid county

A Supplement to the act \* to enable the securities of Christopher Dec. 1787. Edelen, deceased, and his administrator, to collect the balances due to him as collector of the tax, and as sheriff, of Frederick county. Lib. TBH. No. B. fol. 345.

WHEREAS Mountjoy Bayley, administrator, and George Murdock, Jacob Miller, Daniel Hower Preamble. and Thomas Ogle, securities, of Christopher Edelen, deceased, by their petition to this general affembly, have fet forth, that they have not been able to obtain payment of the balances due to the faid Christopher Edelen by virtue of the provision in the said law, because they could not employ a collector for the commission therein allowed, and were not authorised thereby to collect the said balances themselves by execution, and that a scire faciar issued against the said securities, returnable to last October term, to recover the balance due to the state from the said Christopher for the year seventeen hundred and eighty-two, and have therefore prayed that an act may pass, authorising the treasurer to take a bond with security from the administrator aforesaid for the balance due to the state, payable according to the terms of the act relative to the arrearages of taxes due the state before the first day of January, seventeen hundred and eighty-three, and that on neglect of the adminiltrator, the treasurer be empowered to receive such bond from such of the securities as shall offer the same; and that upon a bond being lodged with the treasurer, with satisfactory security, the ad-

ministrator or securities; or both, who may execute such bond, may be invested with a power to collect in person, or by deputy, the balances due to the said Christopher for taxes, and as sherisf; and the faid fecurities have further prayed, that if they should give bond as aforesaid, they also be empowered to proceed on the bond of the faid Christopher to affect the balance of his estate in the hands of his administrator, liable to the claim of the faid state; which being thought reasonable,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the administrator of the said Christo- Administrator pher Edelen, may, at any time before the first day of February next, give bond for the balance due may give bond, from the faid Christopher as aforefaid, with such security, in the manner and on the terms as collectors, of confolidated arrearages of taxes might have given bond under the faid act, relative to the arrearages of taxes due the flate before the first day of January, seventeen hundred and eighty-three, within the time limitted by the faid act; and if the faid administrator shall refuse or naglect to do the fame within the time limitted, that then the faid fecurities, or any or either of them, may give fuch bond as aforesaid at any time thereafter, and before the first day of March next, and either of such bonds given as aforefaid shall be lodged with the treasurer of the western shore, and shall be subject to the fame process and proceedings as may by law be had on other bonds given for arrearages of taxes confolidated; and on such bond being given, and duly approved, and payment of all costs, all further proceedings at law on the faid feire facias shall ceale.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED. That the person or persons giving such bond for the balance due as Person giving aforefaid, shall be and is hereby empowered, in person or by deputy, to receive, collect and levy, all bond to collect, lums of money due to the faid Christopher Edelen as collector or sheriff of Frederick county, by execution or otherwise, in the same manner, and as fully and amply, as the said Christopher Edelen at any time might have received, collected, or levied the same; and there shall and may be allowed, as against the estate of the said Christopher Edelen, a commission for collection, not exceeding ten per cent. any thing in the first mentioned act to the contrary notwithstanding.
