invested with full power and authority, as a body politic, to plead and to be impleaded, to sue and to be fued, to defend and to be defended, to answer and to be answered, by the name of The Trustees for the Poor of Queen-Anne's County, in all and every caule, complaint and action, real, perfonal cormixed, of whatever kind of nature it shall be, in any court of judicature within this state, and by that name they and any of them, and their successors, shall and they are hereby enabled to take, hold, poffels and enjoy, any gift, donation or prefent, which shall or may hereafter be given, deviled or bequeathed, by any person or persons whatsoever, to them, or any of them, for or towards the support and maintenance of the poor in the said county; and they, or any of them, may receive by way of fubscription, any sum or sums of money which shall or may be given for the better and more speedy promoting the benefit and good by this act intended; and that they have full power, authority and ability, to purchase, take, hold, receive, enjoy and have, to them and their successors for ever, any lands, tenements and hereditaments, not exceeding the yearly value of five hundred pounds current money, and are hereby empowered and authorifed to ule one common feal in their business relating to the said corporation, and the same, if necessary, to change and alter; and that the faid persons so incorporated, and their successors, shall be the true and undoubted trustees, in perpetual fuccession, for ever, to be continued in the way and manner hereafter specified, with full and absolute power; liberty and authority, in the making and ordaining such laws, orders and rules, for the better relieving, regulating and letting the poor to work, and punishing vagrants, beggars, vagabonds and other offenders, and for the good government of the faid alms and work-house intheir faid county; as to them and their fuccessors thall, from time to time, think most fit and requisite, all which shall be observed by the overfeer of such alms and work-house, and by all poor, beggars, vagrants, vagabonds and other offenders, in fuch alms and work-house, under the penalties therein contained; provided always, that the faid rules, laws and orders, be no ways contrary to the laws of this state.

V. And, to perpetuate the fuccession of the aforesaid number of nine trustees for the poor in Taid county, BEIT ENACTED, That as often as any one of the faid truftees for the poor shall die, How vacancies of remove himself out of the county, refuse to qualify himself, by taking and subscribing the oaths are to be filled. or affirmations aforesaid, or become incapable of acting, the trustees for the time being, then surviving and remaining within the faid county, or the major part of them, are hereby authorifed and required to elect; nominate and choose, one of the inhabitants of said county in the place and room of fuch truftee, and fo to fill up the full number of truftees for fuch alms and work-house, the which persons so elected and chosen, from time to time, are always to be qualified in the same manner as before by this act is directed.

VI. AND BE IT ENACTED, That every person that by this act appointed as a trustee for the poor, Penalty on reor that shall hereafter be nominated and appointed as such pursuant to the directions thereof, and who fulal to serve, shall wilfully refuse or delay to take upon him the said office, shall forseit and pay, for every such refufallior delay; the fum of ten pounds current money; provided, that no member of the general affembly, clergyman, attorney, or practifing phylician, be obliged to accept of the office of truffee aforelaid, or forfeit as aforelaid for refuling to accept and take upon himself the same, and that no judge of the general court, county magistrate or sheriff, or any one who hath not the qualification to be a member of the general assembly, if elected, shall be capable to be chosen or act as a trustee aforefaid; nor shall any person be compelled to serve in less than three years after he has served, or paid the faid forfeiture for not ferving, as a truffee aforefaid.

VII. And, for enabling the faid trustees to repair and to convert the faid building into alms and work-houses, and to erect and build flich others on the faid land as they may think proper for the purposes herein mentioned, BE IT ENACTED, That the faid trustees, or the major part of them, be Trustees to and they are hereby authorifed and empowered, from time to time, as occasion shall require, to draw upon the collector of Queen-Anne's county for all or any part of the money by this act affeffed, levied and collected, as finall remain in his hands, which the faid truftees, or the major part of them, shall think necessary for the uses and purposes mentioned in this act.

VIII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid trustees, or the major part of them, appointed as To contract aforefaid, shall, and they are hereby authorised, directed and required, to agree and contract with with workmen, a workman or workmen to undertake to repair the faid buildings, and convert them into fuitable and &c. convenient houses, habitations and dwellings, and erect and build such others as they may judge proper and necessary on the said land, (the whole to be completed and finished in a workman-like manner,) for the reception of the poor of the faid county, and of fuch vagrants, beggars, vagabonds and other offenders, as shall be committed by virtue of this act, and they shall appropriate such part
