An ACT to cede to congress a district of ten miles square in this flate for the feat of the government of the United States. IG. No. 1. fol. 77.

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the representatives of this state in the Representatives of the congress of the United States, appointed to assemble at New-tives may cede York on the first Wednesday of March next, be and they are hereby authorised and required, on the any district, &c. behalf of this state, to cede to the congress of the United States any district in this state, not exceeding ten miles square, which the congress may fix upon and accept for the seat of government of the United States.
