and lawful means; and to punish with moderate correction, under fuch rules and regulations as shall be prescribed by the said commissioners, all such negro and other slaves as shall be found wandering or strolling about the streets in the night time, for frequenting the houses of other persons in the faid town, without the permission or consent of their masters, mistresses or overseers.

And, whereas it has likewise been represented, that the inhabitants of the said town, and others, are erecling a market-house in a convenient place therein appropriated to that purpose; and that if the market thereof were properly established and regulated, it might be rendered useful to themselves, and to the citizens of the neighbouring counties; BE IT THEREFORE FURTHER ENACTED, by the authority aforesaid, That from and after the first Monday of April, in the year seventeen hun- Market-days dred and ninety-one, the Tuesday and Saturday in every week-shall thereafter be set apart, appoint- set apart, &c. ed and held, as market-days within the limits of the faid town; and that all victuals and provisions whatsoever brought to the said town for sale, after the said first Monday of April, in the year aforefaid, shall be taken or carried to the public market-house of the said town, and there be fold, or offered for sale, at the market-hours, which are hereby established to be from any time in the morning of the said days until twelve o'clock at noon; provided always, that fish or oysters, or beef by the quarter or larger quantity, or pork by the hog or hogs, or any kind of grain, flour and bread, or butter in firkins, or other veffels exceeding twenty pounds net weight, or cheefe, or beef and pork in barrels or larger casks, or live cattle, sheep and hogs, respectively brought to the said town or market upon the days atorefaid, or on any other days, except Sunday, may be fold, bartered, or otherwise disposed of, in the same manner as if this act had not been passed.

XI. AND BE IT ENACTED, That if any person shall presume to buy, or cause to be bought, any Penalty for article of victuals or provisions, of any other person or persons bringing, or having brought, to the faid town, or within two miles thereof, any kind of victuals or provisions whatsoever for sale, (except the articles herein before provided for,) either upon the stated market-days aforesaid, or on any other days, during the time of the market-hours herein before established, at any other place whatfoever but at or in the faid market-house, such person shall forseit and pay the sum of thirty-shillings current money for every such offence.

XII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That if any fervant or flave shall, by the order or consent of his or On servants her master or mistress, buy any articles of victuals or provisions of any person bringing, or having brought, to the faid town, or within two miles thereof, any kind of victuals or provisions whatfoever for sale, (except the articles provided for as aforesaid,) either upon the stated market-days aforefaid, or on any other days, during the time of the market-hours herein before appointed, at any other place whatfoever but at or in the faid market-house, the master or mistress of every such fervant or flave, to ordering or consenting, shall forfeit and pay the sum of fifteen shillings current money for every offence.

XIII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That if any person whatsoever, after the said first Monday of April, On persons shall presume to fell, or cause to be fold, any article of victuals or provisions whatsoever, which such person may be bringing or sending, or have brought or sent, to the said town, or within two miles thereof, for fale, (except the articles herein before excepted,) either upon the stated market-days aforesaid, or on any other days, during the time of the market-hours herein before established, at any other place whatfoever but at or in the faid market-house, every such person shall sorfeit and pay the fum of fifteen shillings current money for every offence.

XIV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That if any person shall presume to slaughter or butcher any kind of On slaughtercattle, slieep or hogs, in or near the said market-house, or suffer the same to be done, every person ing cattle, &c. fo offending shall forfeit and pay the sum of sisteen shillings current money for every offence.

XV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That if any person, after the time herein before limitted, shall put, On putting or cause to be put, any horse, mare or gelding, into or under the said market-house, on any pretence whatsoever, every such person shall forseit and pay the sum of sive shillings current money for every see.

XVI. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the commissioners of the said town, to be appointed by virtue A clerk to be of this act, shall, on the said first Monday of April, in the year seventeen hundred and ninety-one, appointed, &c. and on the same day and month in every year thereafter, nominate and appoint a person of good repute and skill to be the clerk of the said market; and if the person so appointed shall die, resign, or refuse to act, or be rendered incapable of acting by reason of milbehaviour or removal from office,
