

At a SESSION of the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of MARYLAND, begun and held at the City of ANNAPOLIS, on Monday, the 5th of November, and ended the 23d day of December, in the year of our Lord 1792, the following laws were enacted.

C H A P. I.

An ACT to enable the court of appeals to continue certain causes depending in the said court. Lib. JG. No. 1. fol. 563.

Passed 22d of Dec. 1792.

WHEREAS at June term last past, the said court, from the sickness and non-attendance of some of the counsel concerned in causes then depending in the said court, were induced to adjourn the same until Monday the fifth of this instant, and the said court is now sitting, and several causes before them cannot be heard and determined for want of time;

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the said court of appeals be and they are hereby authorized to continue any cause depending in the said court, until next June term, which they may think proper for a hearing on the merits between the parties, and not for delay.

WHEREAS doubts are entertained respecting the powers of the trustees appointed by the further supplementary act † to the act, entitled, An act for building a new church in the city of Annapolis,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the trustees therein named be and they are hereby authorized and directed to cause not less than eight days notice to be given in the Maryland Gazette, for the subscribers to attend at the said church for the purpose of choosing their pews; and the said trustees are hereby required to give personal notice to all subscribers who do not reside in the city of Annapolis; and that thereafter the said trustees proceed in the choice aforesaid agreeably to the directions of the act, entitled, An act for building a new church in the city of Annapolis.

C H A P. V.

An ACT concerning Forest-street in Baltimore-town, in Baltimore county. Lib. JG. No. 1. fol. 566.

WHEREAS it has been represented to this general assembly, by the petition of the owners of lots, and inhabitants, of Forest-street, and others, in Baltimore-town aforesaid, that by an act of assembly, passed in the year seventeen hundred and fifty-three, for making an addition to Baltimore-town aforesaid, that Forest-street was marked and located, on a plot of said addition, for the width of sixty-six feet, and that previous to the laying out the said addition, the proprietors of the said land did lay out the same only of the width of eighteen feet, and that the street was built on and improved by the said owners of lots of the width of eighteen feet, and that it never was extended or opened of the width of sixty-six feet agreeably to the plot thereof, and that it would be ruinous to many, and extremely injurious to all, the said owners of said lots, if the said street should be extended to sixty-six feet as laid out, without benefitting individuals or the town at large; and the prayer of the said petitioners appearing reasonable,
