convenience of the public, they humbly prayed that the same might be made a public road, and put upon the same footing, and kept up under the same regulations, as other public roads are; all which appearing to this general assembly reasonable; therefore,

Road declared public, &c.

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the road aforesaid, leading from Crooked Run to Saint-Martin's Landing, be and the same is hereby declared, deemed and taken to be, a public road for ever, and hereafter to be kept up and repaired as other public roads are in said county, any law to the contrary in anywise notwithstanding.

C H A P. XIX.

Passed 28th of Dec. 1793.

C H A P. XX.

An ACT to confirm the title of certain lots of ground to the society of people called Quakers, in Baltimore-town, whereon is their meeting-house and burying-ground. Lib. JG. No. 2. fol. 15.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is represented to this legislature, by the monthly meeting of the people called Quakers, in Baltimore-town, that they are seized and possessed of a lot of ground on the east side of Jone's falls, included within York, Harford and Pitt-streets, and Smock-alley, containing, by computation, near four acres, which was purchased by said society before the revolution; for the purpose of erecting a meeting-house, yard, stabling, burying-ground and school-house, and a small piece of said lot to accommodate a school-master, or some person to be employed in taking care of said premises, with a house and garden: And whereas it appears by the bill of rights that no religious society shall hold more than two acres of ground without the leave of the legislature, and the said monthly meeting hath prayed a law might pass to vest the legal estate in the trustees of said meeting, and their heirs and assigns, for the purposes aforesaid; and the prayer of said petition being reasonable, therefore,

Trustees to hold property, &c.

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That it shall and may be lawful for the trustees of said society to have and to hold the property and lots above described, to them, their heirs and assigns, for ever, saving to all and every person their several and respective rights.

For a meeting-house, &c.

III. PROVIDED ALWAYS, AND BE IT ENACTED, That the said property and lots shall be held and enjoyed for a meeting-house, yard, stabling, burying-ground, school-house, and dwelling-house and small garden, to accommodate said school-master, or person taking care of said property, and for no other use or purpose whatever.

C H A P. XXI.

A Supplement to an act, (a) entitled, An act for the inspection of salted provisions exported and imported from and to the town of George-town, in Montgomery county. Lib. JG. No. 2. fol. 15.

A Supplement to an act, * entitled, An act to establish a market at the market-house in Chester-town, in Kent county, and for the regulation of the said market. Lib. JG. No. 2. fol. 16.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, that by the original act to which this is a supplement there is no effectual or direct mode pointed out by means of which the fines, penalties and forfeitures, to be imposed or incurred in consequence of a violation or infringement of the said original act, can or may be recovered, and that the said original act, in other respects, wants aid and amendment; therefore,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That from and after the first day of April next it shall be the duty of the clerk of the said market to try, by standard, the weight of butter, and
