therqua-lified listed and duly appointed or elected to any office of profit or trult, on making affirmation instead of taking the leveral oaths appointed by the constitution and form of government, and the several acts of affembly of this state, now in force, or that hereafter may be made, such person may hold and exercise, any office of profit or trust to which he may be appointed or elected, and may, by such affirmation, qualify himself to take a seat in the legislature, and to act therein as a member of the fame in all cases whatever, or to be an elector of the senate, in as full and ample a manner, to all intents and purposes whatever, as persons are now competent and qualified to act who are not conscienticulty scrupulous of taking such oaths.

II. AND BE IT ENACTED, That if this act shall be confirmed by the general assembly, after the If confirmed, next election of delegates, in the first session after such new election, as the constitution and form of the constitution government directs, that in fuch case this act, and the alterations and amendment of the constitution on, &c. and form of government therein contained, shall be taken and considered, and shall constitute and be valid, as a part of the faid constitution and form of government, to all intents and purposes, any thing in the said constitution and form of government contained to the contrary notwithstanding.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the several clauses and sections of the constitution and form of Clauses, &c. vegovernment contrary to the provisions of this act, fo far as they respect either of the sects or societies aforesaid, shall be and are hereby declared to be repealed and annulled, on the consirmation

This aft was confirmed by 1795, ch. 11, and therefore has become valid as a part of the conflitution.

C H A P.

A Supplement to the act, entitled, An act for the removal of the Dec. 1794. feat of justice from Melville's Warehouse to Pig Point, in Caroline Lib. JG. No. 2. fol. 219. county.

HEREAS by an act of affembly, paffed at November session, seventeen hundred and ninety, * Preamble. entitled, An act for the removal of the feat of justice from Melville's Warehouse to Pig Point, in Caroline county, William Richardson, Zebdiel Potter, Joseph Richardson, Peter Edmondfon and Joshua Willis, were appointed commissioners for Caroline county, which commissioners, or a majority of them, were fully empowered and authorised to purchase a certain quantity of land at Pig Point aforesaid, (now called by the name of Denton,) for the purpose of erecting a court-house and gaol thereon; and the faid commissioners, after purchasing the quantity of land they were authorised by the said act to do, for a certain sum of money contracted with William Benson, of Talbot, to build and complete a court-house on said land, which court-house is still unfinished: And whereas by death, refusal to act, and removal out of the county, of some of the said commissioners, Joseph Richardson is now the only acting commissioner, who is not empowered to fill up the said vacancies, nor to receive the faid court-house when completed; therefore,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Christopher Driver, William Robin- Commissioners fon, Philemon Downes and Thomas Loockerman, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners appointed, &c. for Caroline county aforesaid, in addition to Joseph Richardson, one of the commissioners in the aforesaid act named, who, or a majority of them, are hereby authorised, empowered and required, to execute and perform all the feveral trusts and powers reposed in and required of the commissioners in the faid act appointed which shall or may remain unexecuted by them; and in case any of the said commissioners hereby appointed should die, resuse to act, or remove out of the said county, then and in such case the remaining commissioner or commissioners shall choose another person or persons in the room of him or them fo dying, refuling to act, or removing out of the county aforesaid.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the commissioners appointed by this act, or the majority of them, Who may defhall be and they are hereby authorifed and required to demand, fue for, recover and receive, all mand all momonies or tobacco heretofore levied and collected for the purpose of building the court-house in the faid county, which have not already been received and expended by the commissioners named in the act to which this is a supplement, from any person or persons who by law are chargeable with the payment of the fame, or in whole hands the fame may be, and the faid money or tobacco, when recovered, to apply to the purpose of finishing and completing the said court-house, in the same manner the commissioners in the said act were empowered to do, and agreeable to the contract made by the said commissioners with the said William Benson, and his security.
