the preceding Sunday, and then and there shall elect, viva vece, seven lay members of said congregation as cruftees, and the feven lay members who shall have the majority of legal votes, shall be, and they are hereby declared to be, the lay trustees of faid corporation, and shall succeed those herein appointed, and continue until the next annual election shall take place.

V. AND BE IT ENACTED, That in case any of the lay members of said church, appointed trustees How vacancies in virtue of this act, or who may hereafter be elected truffees, shall die, or remove with a view to are to be filled. relide out of this state, that from and immediately after such death or removal, the surviving trustees, or a majority of them, shall have full power and authority, at their next, or at any subsequent meeting, to elect a lay member in the room of fuch person so deceased or removed, which lay member shall be elected by a majority of the votes of the trustees present, and shall continue in office until the next annual election takes place.

VI. And BE IT ENACTED, That the faid trustees now appointed, and who may hereafter be elect- Trustees to ed, or a majority of them, and their fuccessors, from time to time, as occasion may require, may and meet, &c. shall meet together to transact the business and superintend and protect the property put under their truft and care, and shall make, constitute and alter, such rules and orders for regulating their ownproceedings, and the management of the temporal business of the society of the Roman catholics in the town of Baltimore, as they shall judge most fit, provided that such rules and regulations be not. repugnant to the constitution and laws of this state, or of the United States.

CHAP.

An ACT to incorporate the German reformed congregation in Bal-Paffed 24th of Dec. 1795. timore-town. Lib. JG. No. 2. fol. 285.

TATHEREAS the German reformed congregation of Baltimore-town, by their petition to this Preamble. general affembly, have prayed that they may be incorporated, with powers adequate to the regulation of their temporal concerns, and with authority to take, hold and enjoy, property fufficient for the support of their clergy, and the establishment of schools for the education of their youth; for granting whereof,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That George Troldemier, Michael Dif- G. Troldemier, fendersfer, John Hull, Peter Diffendersfer, Jacob Hossman, George-Decker, Peter Bankert, Christa body politic. topher Dietmor, Philip Gronemiller, Nicholas Tschudy, Richard Ratien and Christian Keener, the &c. present minister, elders, deacons and trustees, of the said congregation, and their successors, chosen in manner herein after mentioned, shall be, and they are hereby crecked into and declared to be, one body politic and corporate, by the name and style of The Elders, Deacons and Trustees, of the German Reformed Congregation of Baltimore-town, and by the fame name and flyle fhall have perpetual fuccession, and be able and capable in law to sue or be sued; plead or be impleaded, answer or be answered unto, in any court of law or equity within this state, and to make, change or alter, at pleafure, a common feal, and shall be able and capable to purchase, take, hold, receive and enjoy, any estate, real, personal or mixed, not exceeding, in the whole, the clear yearly value of twelve hundred pounds, current money.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the male members of the congregation aforefaid, of the full age Male members of twenty-one years, may and shall meet on Easter Monday in every year, from and after the passing to meet, &c. of this act; or within ten days thereafter, at the church of the faid congregation, or such other convenient place in Baltimore-town as may be chosen by the officiating elders, deacons and trustees, and notified during the time of divine fervice on Easter Sunday to the congregation, and then and there elect four persons, members of the said congregation, to be elders, four other persons to be deacons, and three other persons to be trustees of the said congregation, and the persons so elected, together. with the minister for the time being, shall be the elders, deacons and trustees, of the said congregation, until another election be held in pursuance of this act.

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the elders, deacons and trustees; now appointed, or who may Elders, &c. to hereafter be elected, or a majority of them, shall and may meet together from time to time, and as meet, &c. often as they may judge expedient, to transact and manage the business of the said society, and superintend and protect the property thereof, and make fuch by-laws and regulations for the good conduct of their proceedings and the management of their temporal concerns as to them may appear expedient, not being repugnant to the discipline of the said church, or to the constitution and laws of
