WHEREAS Daniel of Saint Thomas Jenifer, while agent for this state, fold several tracks or Preamble. parcels of land the property of faid state: And whereas doubts have arisen whether the purchalers of faid lands can obtain complete titles under any exilting law;

II. BE TT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That in all cases of fales made by the Chancellor to said Daniel of Saint Thomas Jenifer, the chancellor shall be and he is hereby authorised and required, examine, &c. upon the application of the purchaser or purchasers thereof, or their heirs or assigns, to examine into the fituation of such fale, and upon being satisfied that the applicant is entitled to the land claimed, and that the whole purchase money and interest hath been paid, to execute, on behalf of this state, a deed of conveyance of all the flate's interest therein to luch person or persons as shall be legally

CHAP. XIV.

An ACT to enable the vestry of Christ Church parish, in Calvert county, to sell and dispose of certain lands therein mentioned.

WHEREAS the vestry of Christ Church parish, in Calvert county, by their petition to this ge- Preamble. neral affembly have represented, that they now hold a track of land called The Gore, which is, in its present situation, but of little utility to the said parish, and that if the said lands could be fold, the money arising from the sale might be applied to beneficial purposes, in improving another tract of land held by the faid veftry, and become the means of accommodating a pafter in the fame; therefore,

II. BE AT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the faid vestry, in their corporate Vestry may fell capacity, are hereby authorifed, after giving thirty days notice at the most public places in the said land, &c. county, to fell and dispose of the said tract of land called The Gore, with the appertenances, by public sale, either for ready money, or on such credit as the said vestry may deem necessary in ordet to fell the faid lands to the best advantage, and such sale so made, and evidenced by deed of bargain and fale, executed and acknowledged by the faid veftry, or a majority of them, agreeably to the laws of this state, shall be good to all intents and purposes to convey all the right, and title and interest, of the faid parish or vestry, and their successors, for ever, to such bargainee or bargainees, and their heirs, for ever.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid westry are hereby authorised and required to apply the Apply the mofum or fums of money arising from the sale aforesaid to the purposes of erecting buildings, and augmenting the improvements on a cortain tract of land called Charles's Gift, for the benefit of the faid parish, now in the occupation of the faid vestry.

IV. And BE IT ENACTED, That before the faid vestry shall proceed in the execution of the Give bond to authority vested in them by this act, they shall give bond to the state of Maryland, in such sum and the state, &c. with fuch fecurity as one or both of the affociate judges of the faid county court shall think proper or approve of, conditioned for the faithful performance of the authority and duties vested in and impoled on them by this act.
