C H A P. XXVI.

A Supplement to the act, * entitled, An act to improve and repair the streets in Frederick-town, in Frederick county, and for other purposes therein mentioned. Lib. JG. No. 2. fol. 462.

Preamble.

WHEREAS a number of the inhabitants of the several additions to Frederick-town, in Frederick county, by their petition to this general assembly have set forth, that they are desirous the same shall be annexed to the said town, and be put under the control and authority of the commissioners; therefore,

Additions annexed to the town, &c.

II. BE IT ENACTED, *by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the several additions to Frederick-town, in Frederick county, be and are hereby annexed to the said town, and that the commissioners of Frederick-town aforesaid shall have the same power, jurisdiction and authority, over the said additions, that they have heretofore had and exercised over the said town, under and in virtue of the act to which this is a supplement, any law, usage or custom, to the contrary notwithstanding.

C H A P. XXVII.

An ACT to confirm the divisions made in the city of Washington of the estate of John Davidson, deceased, and for other purposes. Lib. JG. No. 2. fol. 462. A Private Act.

C H A P. XXVIII.

An ACT to authorise and empower the levy court of Montgomery county to assess and levy annually a sum of money for the support of Hannah Carter. Lib. JG. No. 2. fol. 464.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Hannah Carter, of Montgomery county, by her petition to this general assembly, hath set forth, that she is in her old age, and hath procured an honest livelihood by her labour until she had an attack of the palsy, which deprived her of the use of her limbs, since which she has been supported by the tender care of her daughter, now a widow with several small children, with whom she is anxious to remain during the remainder of her days, having an aversion to go to the poor-house, where she would be deprived of the comfort and tenderness of her said daughter, and prays an act may pass to provide for her future maintenance; the facts stated in said petition appearing to be true; therefore,

Justices to levy money, &c.

II. BE IT ENACTED, *by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the justices of Montgomery county shall be and they are hereby directed and empowered, at their levy court annually, so long as they shall see cause, to assess and levy on said county a sum of money, not exceeding forty dollars, for the support and maintenance of the said Hannah Carter, and that the same be collected and paid annually by the collector of Montgomery county to such person as the levy court of said county shall and may direct.

C H A P. XXIX.

An ACT to authorise and empower the justices of the levy court of Kent county to assess and levy a sum of money on the inhabitants of said county for the purpose therein mentioned. Lib. JG. No. 2. fol. 465.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, that the court-house in Kent county stands in need of repairs and alterations, so that the public records of said county may be kept secure; therefore,

Justices to levy money, &c.

II. BE IT ENACTED, *by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the justices of the peace of Kent county, or any five of them, shall be and they are hereby empowered and directed to assess and levy, at such time or times as they may think proper, on the assessable property of Kent county aforesaid, any sum of current money, not exceeding four hundred pounds, together with the collector's compensation of six *per cent.* for collecting the same; which said monies, so to be assessed and levied, shall be
