XV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid agent be authorifed to superintend the collection of all Agent to superbalances due on bond taken for taxes due before the first day of January, seventeen hundred and lection, &c. eighty-three; and the faid agent shall also superintend the collection of all balances due on bonds initalied, or otherwife, for the emission of paper money of seventeen hundred and fixty-nine; and seventeen hundred and seventy-three.

XVI: AND BE IT ENACTED, That no process shall issue against any of the public debtors, unless No process to by the direction of the faid agent.

XVII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid agent shall have power to fix such days for the sale of Agent to fix property taken by fieri facias, at the fuit of the state, as he may think proper, always taking care to days, &c. give at least twenty days public notice thereof, and the faid agent shall also have power to suspend the fales, from time to time, as he may think most to the advantage of the state.

XVIII, AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid agent shall pay into the treasury, in specie, the Andpayspecie. amount of all specie by him received in the discharge of the duties of this act.

XIX. AND BE IT ENACTED, That in all cases where bonds shall be taken in virtue of this Bonds to be a act, the bonds hall be a lien on all the real property of the obligors from the date thereof, or on lien. fo much of the faid real property as the governor and council shall think sufficient, to be particularly mentioned in a schedule to be annexed to the faid bond, in which case it shall be a lien on the property contained in fuch schedule; and no more, such bond and schedule to be lodged with the treasurer of the western shore.

XX. AND BE IT ENACTED, That all bonds, taken in virtue of this act, shall express the county And to express in which the obligors respectively reside, and the treasurer of the western shore shall, within one the county, &c. month after he receives them respectively, cause them, with the schedule annexed to them, to be recorded in the office of the clerk of the general court of the western shore at the expence of the obligors; and a copy of the faid record, certified under the hand and official feal of the faid clerk, shall be as good evidence in any court of law or equity in this state as the original bond would be if it was produced; and if any of the obligors in any fuch bonds refide on the eastern shore, the said treasurer shall, within fix months from the time he receives the same respectively, transmit to the clerk of the general court of the eastern shore, in the same manner as papers on public service are transmitted, a copy of such bonds and schedules, certified as asoresaid by the clerk of the general court of the western shore, to be recorded in the office of the clerk of the general court of the eastern shore, at the expence of the obligors, and, in such case, a copy of the said record, certified as aforefaid by the faid clerk of the general court of the eastern shore, shall be good evidence as aforesaid.

XXI. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid agent shall render to the treasurer of the western shore Agent to rendistinct quarterly accounts of his receipts of all money, certificates and bonds, in virtue of this act, der quarterly and shall immediately thereupon pay and deliver the same to the said treasurer, who shall, in his an-accounts, &c. nual report to the general assembly, state fully and particularly the money, certificates and bonds, by him received from the faid agent, and the times when the same were received and accounted for.

XXII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid agent shall render a fair and full account of his seve- A fair account ral proceedings, under the authority of this acl, to the general assembly at their next session, and to the general within the first ten days after its commencement, in which account shall be specified, under distinct heads, his own receipts, and those of the treasurer, and of all transfers of stock upon which he may be entitled to commissions, and in which shall also be contained a particular estimate of his commission ons, fliewing how and upon what the same arose due.
