city of Annapolis; and the faid subscriptions shall be opened on the second Monday in April next, of which fix weeks previous and fuccessive notice shall-be given in the Baltimore-town, George-town, Easton and Annapolis papers; and the subscription books shall be continued open until the capital aforefaid shall be subscribed, and on the completion thereof, a just and true list of all the subscribers, with the shares subscribed by each, shall be made out and returned by the said managers under their lands, to the clerks of Baltimore, Anne-Arundel, and Prince-George's county courts, who are hereby feverally authorifed and directed to record the fame among the land records of their respective counties, and an attested copy of such record, under the hand of the said clerks, and seal of their office, or either of them, shall in all cases be sufficient evidence of such subscription.

II. AND BE IT, ENACTED, That as foon as five hundred shares shall be subscribed, the persons A meeting may hereby empowered to take in subscriptions, or any eight of them, may call a meeting of the subscribers, at the city of Washington, after not less than four successive weeks notice in the Baltimoretown, George-town, Easton and Annapolis news-papers; and the subscribers assembled in consequence of fuch notice shall choose, by ballot, from among the subscribers, by a majority of the votes of such as shall be present, in person or by proxy, twelve directors for the term of one year thereaster, and on the same day annually, for ever thereafter, a like election shall be made; and in case of resusal, death, relignation, disqualification, or removal out of the state, of any director, the remaining directors, at their meeting thereafter, shall elect; by ballot, another person qualified as aforesaid in his place, for the residue of the year; the directors, or any seven of them, shall, at their first meeting after every general election, elect; by a majority of the members prefent, by ballot, from among the flockholders, a president, who shall, whether a director or not, be thereupon entitled to all the powers and privileges of one, and if he was before a director, another director shall be elected as aforesaid, so as to keep up the number of directors prescribed by this act, exclusive of the president; and in tale of refusal, death, refignation, disqualification, or removal out of the state, of the president, the directors shall meet, as soon as conveniently can be thereafter, and elect another person for prefident in the manner before directed.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the stockholders in the faid company shall be and they are here. Stockholders by incorporated, and constituted a body corporate and politic, by the name of The President, Directors and Company, of the Washington Turnpike Road, and by the same name shall have succesfion during the continuance of this incorporation; and the faid stockholders, and their successors, by the name aforesaid, may sue and be sued, answer and be answered, in any court of law or equity in this state, and may do and execute every other matter and thing by the name aforesaid that they are authorised to do in virtue of this act, and shall have power to make a seal, and alter, or break and senew the fame, according to their will and pleasure.

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That after the faid directors shall be appointed, they sliall have full Directors to repower and authority to receive subscriptions for all unsubscribed or vacant shares, and thereupon the ceive subscriptions, &c. powers heretofore vested in the managers for taking subscriptions shall cease; and that there be a meeting of the directors quarterly, for the purpose of regulating the affairs of the corporation, any seven of whom to make a board, and that the board have power to adjourn from time to time; and the prefident, or any three of the directors, may call a special meeting at any other time they may think necellary.

V. And BE IT ENACTED, That the president and directors be and are hereby authorised to appoint on point five commissioners, neither of whom shall be an inhabitant of Anne-Arundel, Baltimore or missioners. &c. Prince-George's counties, or directly or indirectly interested in any of the lands through which the faid road may or shall pass; and the said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall lay out and mark a public road from the city of Washington to Baltimore-town, on as streight a line as the nature of the country, and public convenience, will admit; provided that the faid road shall not be carried through any building, garden, yard, or bearing apple orchard, without the confent of the owner and possessor thereof.

VI. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid commissioners, before they proceed to the execution of Who shall take the powers vested in them by this act, shall take the following oath, or affirmation: " I, A. B. ap- an oath, &c. " pointed a commissioner to lay out and mark a public road from the city of Wallington to Baltimore-town, will lay out and mark the same according to the best of my skill and judgment, and " according to the directions of an act of affembly, entitled, An act to lay out and establish a turn-" pike road from the city of Washington to Baltimore-town; I do further swear, or assirm, that I am not invested in any lands through which the said road is likely to pass."
