shall be condemned by the faid commissioners, appointed as aforesaid to lay out said road, shall apply to the prefident and directors for any latisfaction for the addition of the forty-fix feet to the prefent legal breadth of the faid road, the faid prefident and directors, or a majority of them, may agree with the owner or owners of faid land, for the purchale of the additional quantity, required ; and the faid prefident and directors may agree with any owner or owners of land through which the faid road may be newly carried, for the purchase thereof, and in case of disagreement, or in case the owner shall be a feme-covert, under age, or non compos, or out of the state or county, on application to any one justice of the county in which such lands may lie, the faid justice shall issue his warrant, under his hand, to the theriff of his county, commissioning him to summon twelve freeholders, inhabitants of the faid county, not related to the faid owner, nor in any manner interested, to meet on the land to be valued, at a day to be expressed in the warrant, of which five days notice shall be given by the faid fheriff to the owner of the faid land, or left at his last place of abode, or given to his or her guardian, if an infant, or if out of the state or county, by publishing notice thereof not less than eight weeks successively in the George-town or one of the Baltimore papers; and the fheriff, on receiving the faid warrant, shall then summon the faid jury, and when met, shall administer an oath, or affirmation, to every juryman, who shall swear, or affirm, as his case may require, that he will justly, faithfully and impartially, value the lands, and all damages the owner thereof will fustain by the road passing through the same, having regard to all circumstances of conveniencies, benefits or disadvantages, according to the best of his skill and judgment, and the inquisition there-

XII. And BE IT ENACTED, That in all cases where stone, gravel or other materials, shall be And also for necessary for making or repairing the said road, the said president and directors, or a majority of stone, gravel, them, may agree with the owner or proprietors of the faid materials for the purchase of the same, or with the faid owner or owners of the land on which the fame may be, for the purchase of the said land, and in case of disagreement, or in case the owner should be a feme-covert, under age, or non compes, or out of the state or county, on application to one justice of the county in which such materials may lie, may proceed in all respects in the same manner for condemning the said materials for the use of said road, as in the like cases where lands are directed to be taken and condemned as aforefaid, for making the faid road, and the faid parties respectively shall have the same benefit and advantage of the faid proceedings as they will have under and in virtue of the faid provision for condemning land herein before mentioned.

upon taken, shall be figned by the sheriff, and seven or more of the faid jury, and shall be conclusive, and the fame shall be returned to the clerk of the county; to be by him recorded at the expence of the faid company; and the valuation expressed in such inquisition shall be paid by the said president and directors to the owner of the lands, or his legal representative, before the faid president and

AND BE IT ENACTED, That if any person shall alter or change, or in any manner obstruct Penalty for alor encroach on, the faid public road, or any part thereof, or cut down and destroy any turnpike gate, tering the or cut, destroy, desace or remove, any mile stones set up on said road, or put or place any rubbish, dirt; logs, flones, or any other obstruction in the said road, or make any pit or hole therein, such person may be indicted in the county court, and being thereof convicted, shall be fined or imprisoned; in the discretion of the court, according to the nature of the offence; and the president and directors shall cause any obstructions or nuisances on the said road to be removed, and shall restore the fame to its proper state and condition.

XV AND BE IT ENACTED, That as foon as the road shall be completed in the manner directed An account to by this act, the president and directors shall forthwith transmit to the governor and council a full and be transmitted, fair account of the cost of said road, and the amount of tolls received previous to its completion, and shall annually thereafter transmit to the governor and council a yearly account of the tolls received and expences incurred on faid road.

XVI.
