CHAP.

An ACT to prevent the going at large of swine within five miles of the city of Baltimore, in Baltimore county. Lib. IG. No. 2.

fol. 582. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That from and after the first day of March, No swine to go in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety-eight, no swine shall be suffered at large, &c. to go at large within five miles of the city of Baltimore, and if any person shall find on his land, or on any land in his polletion, lying within five miles of the faid city, any fwine, it shall and may be lawful for him any fuch fwine to kill or impound; or cause to be killed or impounded.

II. AND BE IT ENACTED, That if any person shall be sued for killing or impounding any swine General issue found upon his land, or on any land in his possession, the defendant may plead the general issue, and pleadable, &c. give this act and the special matter in evidence; provided, that nothing in this act shall be construed to extend to or prevent any fwine going at large in Arme-Arundel county.

HEREAS Thomas Shewell, of Harford county, by his petition to this general affembly hath Preamble. fet forth, that he is an extreme poor man, and that he hath a fon, who has for a confiderable time been afflicted with lumacy, and is unable to support his family with the incumbrance of faid lunatic, and praying that a law may pass to provide for the support of his said son out of the poorhouse'; and the prayer of faid petition appearing reasonable, therefore,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the justices of Harford county shall Justices to levy be and they are hereby directed and empowered, at their levy courts annually, as long as they may money, &c. fee cause, to affess and levy on faid county a sum of money not exceeding forty dollars, for the support and maintenance of the faid fon of the faid.
