C H A P. XVIII.

An ACT authorifing the justices of the levy court of Somerset coun- Jan. 1798. ty to levy a sum of money on the assessable property of the said county for building a prison in the county, and other purposes therein mentioned. Lib. JG. No. 2. fol. 590.

WHEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, that there is no prison in Somerset coun. Preamble, and fecurity of the faid county;

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Messieurs John Done, George Commissioners Robertson, Levin Winder, William Jones, (Menokin,) Levin Gale, Zadock Long and John Stewart, appointed, &c. or the major part of them, shall be commissioners, and are hereby authorised to purchase, for the use of Somerfet county, a piece of ground in the town of Princels-Anne, in faid county, whereon to build a new prison; and the said commissioners, or a majority of them, are hereby empowered to contract for materials, and to agree with workmen to build and finish the faid prison, and to plan and superintend the faid building until finished, which, when completed, shall, by the faid commisfioners, be put into the custody and possession of the sheriff of Somerset county for the time being, and fo shall remain and continue in the custody and possession of such sheriff, and his successors, as a public prison for Somerset county.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the justices of the levy court for Somerset county, at the time Justices to levy of laying their next county levy, be and they are hereby authorifed and directed to impose on the money, &c. affeliable property of the faid county a fum not exceeding four thousand dollars, together with an allowance to the collector of fix per cent. for collection of the same; which sum, when collected, shall, by the said sheriff, be paid to the commissioners aforesaid, or the major part of them, to be by them applied in purchasing the ground, and erecting the said prison.

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the sheriff, or other person appointed to collect the said sum of To be paid to money for the purpose aforesaid, shall pay the same to the said commissioners, or the order of the the commissionmajor part of them, at or before the time limitted by law for the payment of the county charges in ers, &c. the year seventeen hundred and ninety-eight, and in default thereof the said sheriff or collector shall be answerable for all interest, damages and costs, which may be payable by, or may arise or accrue to, the faid commissioners, in consequence of the said default.

V. AND BE IT ENACTED, That if the collector or sheriff, as the case may be, should not pay the If not paid faid fum of money to the commissioners, or the order of a major part of them, on the day above process to issue, mentioned, that it shall be the duty of the said commissioners, or a majority of them, to order a copy of the faid theriff's or collector's bond, as the cafe may be, to be filed in the clerk's office of the county court of Somerfet county, and thereupon a common capias ad respondendum shall issue, and judgment or trial be had at the first court to which the capias is returnable, without any imparlance or delay.

VI. AND BE IT ENACTED, That if any of the faid commissioners shall die, remove out of the How vacancies county, or refuse to act, the relidue, or a majority of them, shall immediately thereafter proceed to are to be filled. nominate and appoint another to fill the vacancy.

VII. WHEREAS it is also represented to this general assembly, that for want of a sufficient gaol in faid county that some of the inhabitants thereof were induced, by their love of justice, and a wish for the public fecurity; to advance a confiderable fum of money to defray the expences of a guard, for the lafe keeping of a number of criminals committed to the cullody of the sheriff of said county for the murder of a certain Joshua Knight; and it appearing reasonable and just that all the inhabitants of faid county should bear an equal proportion of said expence; therefore, BE IT ENACTED, Money to be by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the justices of the levy court of Somerfet county, at the levied, &c. time of laying their next county levy, be and they are hereby directed to levy on the affeffable property of the faid county a fum of money, not exceeding five hundred dollars, together with an allowance of fix per cent. for collection; which fum, when collected, shall be by the sherisf or collector, as the case may be, paid to the honourable John Done, or his order, to be by him paid to the several Cabscribers Rrrr
