And BE IT ENACTED, That the faid commissioners, or a majority of them, shall be and are hereby authorised and required to contract and agree for the building of the said gaol, and to direct Commissioners the plans of the same, which said gaol shall be erected on the ground appropriated by law for that to contract, &c. purpose, and when erecled, finished and completed, shall be used, held, taken and deemed to be, the proper gaol of Montgomery county.

V. AND BE IT ENACTED. That the faid commissioners, or a majority of them, shall render a full Account to be and fair account to the levy court of faid county of the receipts and expenditures of all monies rendered, &c. which shall be by them received and expended in virtue of this act.

## C. H. A. P. C. XXII.

## An ACT to encourage the destruction of wolves and crows in the Passed 20th of several-counties therein mentioned. Lib. JG. No. 2. fol. 597.

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That as often as any free person or persons Justice to give shall bring before any justice of the peace within the counties of Harsord or Montgomery the a certificate, bank of any walk or walves, and make outh, or affirmation, that the walf or walves of head or heads of any wolf or wolves, and make outh, or affirmation, that the wolf or wolves of which he or they produce the head or heads were actually caught and killed within the limits of that county in which he or they pray an allowance, and within fix days next before the producing the fame to fuch justice, that then fuch justice shall, and he is hereby authorised and directed to give fuch person or persons producing a certificate for such head or heads produced and proved as aforefaid, and in such certificate to mention the oath, or affirmation, taken, and therein distinguishing which or how many of the heads of the old or young wolves; and every justice who shall have any wolf's head or heads brought before him by any person or persons as aforesaid, shall be and he is hereby authorifed and empowered to judge of the age of the faid wolf or wolves, of which the head or heads was brought before him, and if such justice shall believe the age of such wolf or wolves to exceed fix months, that then he shall distinguish the same in his certificate by the words Old Wolf or wolves; and that every justice before whom any wolf's head is brought, and by whom a certificate shall be given as aforesaid, is hereby authorised and directed, immediately to cause the ears to be cut off, and the tongue taken out of and from the head or heads of fuch wolf or wolves, and burnt, to prevent such head or heads from being a second time carried before a justice in order to obtain a certificate.

II. AND BE IT ENACTED. That every person or persons who shall produce a certificate as afore- To be allowed. faid to the justice of the county wherein the said wolf or wolves were killed, at the levy court, at the levy shall, for every old wolf's head be allowed thirty dollars, and for every young wolf's head be allow- court, &c. ed four dollars, to be by the faid justices affested and levied in the county levy, together with the collector's falary for collecting the fame, and to be paid by the collector to fuch person or persons as shall be entitled to the same as aforesaid.

III. And BE IT ENACTED, That if any person residing in Harford, Montgomery or Cacil coun- Persons to be ties, shall bring to any justice of the peace of the county in which such person shall reside, the head allowed, &c. or heads of any crow or crows, fuch person shall, for every such head, be allowed in the county levy of the faid county the fum of eight cents, and the justice of the peace before whom such head or heads shall be brought, is hereby required to give the person bringing the same a certificate thereof, and cause the said head or heads to be burnt, or otherwise destroyed.

IV. PROVIDED NEVERTHELESS, AND BE IT ENACTED, That no person whatsoever sliall be entitled Provision to any allowance for any such head or heads, without first making oath, or affirmation, as the case, may be, that fuch crow or crows was or were killed in the county where fuch certificate is applied for, and that no certificate hath been obtained from any other justice of the peace for the same; and that it shall be the duty of each and every justice of the peace before whom such head or heads may be brought by virtue of this or any other act now existing for the destruction of crows, to take and receive the oath, or affirmation, of the party bringing the fame, free and clear from all charge against
